

✓ Organized the "Innovation and Entrepreneurship 2016" event for the first time, emphasizing on alumni start-ups and building and Entrepreneurial Eco-System in Chania



✓ Organized an entrepreneurship contest, within the event, among the TUC community. Received ideas in the areas of IT, electronics, environment, architecture, UAV's , telecommunications, medical screening

TUC Innovation Initiative Action Plan - 2

Collaboration with **The People's Trust and Do-School**:

- **Do-athon Workshop** a two day workshop for 100-120 people on innovation and entrepreneurship taught by the Do-School experts.
- **Do-gether Course** Attract applications and choose the best members from the Do-athon for the Do-gether. 20-30 individuals with some one-to-one sessions, webinars and online sessions.
- Micro-financing The idea will be that as people meet their targets or once the training has been complete, then The People's Trust would also make some grants available.





TUC Innovation Initiative Action Plan - 3

Development of an **Innovation House at TUC**:

- The aim of the TUC Innovation House is to promote entrepreneurship within the Technical University of Crete and in general the greater area of Crete.
- The TUC Innovation House will be an independent company that will spin-off from the Development Company of TUC and its legal status will be determined in the next few months.
