## January 2017

**LAST DAY** to choose Pass/Fail grading option.  
10, Fri **LAST DAY** for graduate students to register and  
pay without having degree status discontinued.  
20, Mon **LAST DAY** for **undergraduate** degree

Petitions for extensions are due in the students'  
deans' offices.  
**Residence Halls close** for Spring Recess,  
6:00 p.m.  
13, Mon- **SPRING RECESS**  
17, Fri  
20, Mon Classes resume  
Second half semester classes begin.  
**LAST DAY** for **graduate** degree candidates to file  
an Intent-to-Graduate for **May 2017** without  
\$25 late fee.

from **Fall 2016** or **JTerm 2017** are due in  
Dean's Offices for all undergraduates and  
all other students with **IC** grades in 200

## May 2017

1, Mon **LAST DAY** announced written or oral **exams**  
may be given **before** finals.  
8, Mon **LAST DAY** of **classes**.  
Deadline for **graduate level** coursework  
resolving **Fall 2016** or **JTerm 2017 IC** grades.  
Petitions for extensions are due in the  
Graduate School, Thompson Hall.  
**LAST DAY** to file completion of minor form for  
May graduates.  
**LAST DAY** to change college until June.  
**LAST DAY** for presenting final copies of  
Ph.D. dissertation or master's thesis to  
Graduate School for binding (**May 2017**  
**graduation**).  
9, Tues Reading Day  
10, Wed Reading Day  
11, Thurs Final Exams begin  
15, Mon Special grade reports resolving **Fall 2016** or  
**JTerm 2017 IC** grades are due in the  
Graduate School for all graduate degree and  
non-degree students with IC grades in **800- or**  
**900- level courses**.
