

Debt looms for over half first-year students

Report predicts grants freeze and benefits axe, warn authors • Quarter of those questioned worked part-time due to debts



More than half of the first-year students at 19 British universities have debts, according to a report by the Higher Education Funding Council for England. The report, which was published in the summer of 1991, found that 54 per cent of first-year students had debts of over £500. The average debt was £1,000, with some students owing as much as £5,000. The report also found that 25 per cent of first-year students worked part-time during the year to help pay for their debts. The authors of the report warn that the Government's proposed cuts to university funding will make it even more difficult for students to pay for their debts.
