I hope you had a nice Eid in Abu Dhabi.

The heat and humidity have settled in on Washington and the politicians are beginning to leave the city for the summer, but some of us labor on.

I was wondering if you could give me an idea of when the first \$5m contribution to the MEI Capital Campaign would be arriving. Did you get all of the explanation you needed about our publicity plan? To recap:

- —In November, at the Annual Banquet and 70th anniversary, i will say that we are half way to our goal of \$40m in pledges, from a variety of our past friends and donors
- —Sometime in 2017, we will file our Not-for-Profit (501c3) tax return with the government. That will identify all sources of revenue. Because we are a Not-for-Profit institution, our filing will be available for public inspection. It is possible a reporter might look at the file and write a story, but that may also not happen.
- —We understand that you do not want to brag about the gift or have something named after you, but we believe that steps to "hide" the contribution would not be a good idea. It would look like we were trying for some reason to cover up the relationship. That would provoke questions and suspicion. We are proud of our long history with the UAE.
