## Costings for group bookings

### VET Accredited Training Programs

Certificate II in Hospitality (Kitchen Operations)  
Certificate II in Horticulture

#### Half-Day Program

**\$195 for 2 hour session**  
(Includes 15 min break)

#### Full Day Program

**\$390 for 4 hour session**  
(Includes 15 min morning tea and 30 min lunch)

### Non Accredited Training Programs

Hands on Horticulture  
Hands on Hospitality

#### Half-Day Program

**\$170 for 2 hour session**  
(Includes 15 min break)

#### Full Day Program

**\$340 for 4 hour session,**  
(Includes 15 min morning tea and 30 min lunch)



Please Note: All Hospitality sessions require an additional \$50 fee to cover food costs. Individual students or smaller groups may be able to join larger groups already enrolled in the program.

### Individual Enrolments - CERES Wednesday VETiS Program 1:45-4:45pm

Cert II in Hospitality - \$1800\* per year

12 places per class are available in this program (minimum of 10 per group)

Cert II in Horticulture - \$1200\* per year

15 places per class are available in this program (minimum of 10 per group)

*\* individual students enrolling in courses may be eligible for government subsidies please contact CERES Training Manager or refer to DEECD funding eligibility indicator on the DEECD Website. Subsidies are based on contact hours for each student. The Government supports schools in other ways for VET where students are not eligible for the VTG.*
