SUBJECT:

The Commission will hold a public comment hearing pursuant to the request of Cross Community Coalition ("CCC"), with and through its counsel Earthjustice and the provisions of Section 25-7-114.5 Colorado Revised Statutes to consider the notice of a draft revised permit modification and preliminary determination of approval for modifications to the Title V Permit for the Suncor Energy Refinery Plants 1 and 3 located at 5801 Brighton Boulevard, Commerce City, Colorado. Section 25-7-114.5 Colorado Revised Statutes provides an opportunity for the applicant or interested parties to request a public hearing before the Commission to seek the comments of any interested person regarding the adequacy of the preliminary analysis and whether the permit should be approved or denied.
