





Described as a 'cultural centre for wine', the sleek Monvínic is a multitasking venue. In the front, the interactive wine lists enable customers to take their pick from between 3,000 and 4,000 labels, searching by origin, year or grape. At the rear, guests can dine on sophisticated Mediterranean market cuisine at the communal Corian tables. Monvínic hosts wine tastings and has a members' club,

and there's a browsable research library of books on viniculture. The polished interior is the work of local designer Alfons Tost, who has combined oak floors and a brass-coloured ceiling with some imaginative lighting.
