Starting in 2013, UNDP has been privileged to partner with the Performance Management Division, As part of the *Strengthening of Performance Management Systems* project, UNDP provided technical assistance to help

organize a global roundtable on performance management systems that brought together eleven countries, all recognized as international leaders in administrative reform. Under the government's leadership, a flagship compendium comparing performance monitoring and evaluation practices from across the world has been prepared using the presentations and inputs from the roundtable.





A community of practice, known as the Government Performance Management Peer Assisted Learning (GOPEMPAL) has been established with the aim of documenting and promoting knowledge on performance management. The Community of Practice is anchored at the Institute of Public Enterprise in Hyderabad and already includes hundreds of government officials and professionals.

With the strengthening aim of Results Framework several Documents, technical resource agencies are also providing expert training and mentoring to key ministries and departments. Resource agencies are also helping ministries implement ISO 9001 quality standards. As a result of this support, ten departments have obtained ISO 9001 quality certification; an additional 29 departments and ministries have completed the documentation and will be certified shortly.

Key initiatives underway

Under its on-going partnership with Performance Management Division in the Cabinet Secretariat, it has been agreed that UNDP will:

- Provide technical assistance to help strengthen performance management systems
- **Facilitate** access to global best practices in performance management
- **Provide** training and mentoring to ministries and state departments to help prepare Corruption Mitigation Action Plans, Innovation Action Plans and to implement ISO 9001 quality standards.

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
