Arkansas Crime Trends, is a comprehensive report on crime, based on summary information submitted by law enforcement agencies as a part of the Arkansas Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program. The Arkansas Crime Information Center publishes an annual report, "Crime in Arkansas," on the statistics of reported criminal offenses. It provides the detailed data necessary for a more comprehensive statistical analysis of crime in Arkansas. This publication takes this one step farther in the understanding of the crime trends which have occurred during the past 10 years. This document analyzes and compares data from the years of 1989 and 1998, with an emphasis on crime index offenses.

Information related to Crime Index offenses is based on reports by law enforcement agencies of the total number of known offenses. These offenses include four violent crime offenses (murder, rape, robbery, and aggravated assault), as well as four property crime offenses (burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft, and arson). Each of these offenses was selected because of its serious nature, frequency of occurrence, and reliability of reporting from citizens to law enforcement agencies.

The purpose of this publication is to aid law enforcement agencies, government officials, educators, and the general public with a better understanding of the crimes, as well as the demographic characteristics, which occur throughout the state. Through this understanding, more emphasis may be placed on resources necessary to effectively fight crime in Arkansas.








Drug Offense Arrests






Total Arrests
