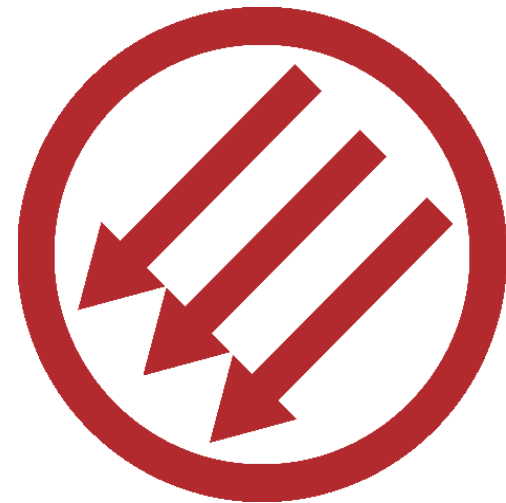

Portland Stands United Against Fascism

On Friday May 26, 2017, Portland white supremacist Jeremy Joseph Christian viciously attacked three brave, working class men who intervened to de-escalate and interrupt his racist harassment of young black and muslim women. One of the men died almost instantly, another died in the hospital, and the third recovered from near-fatal wounds.

Christian was known to Portland anti-fascist activists, because he had attended Joey Gibson's "Free Speech" rally on 82nd Avenue less than a month earlier, giving fascist salutes, and shouting hate speech and threats at activists. Beforehand, he filled the event's Facebook pages with unmoderated neo-nazi rhetoric. Multiple people brought this warning to the attention of Gibson and other apparent event organizers. The day of the event, Christian was not allowed to stand next to the other far-right attendees of the rally because of his brazen bad optics. But he was not the only white supremacist in attendance at that rally. Others, who were quieter and more media-friendly, were allowed to gather, proselytize, and recruit.

We are not surprised that violent white supremacists are drawn to Joey Gibson's rallies, given the constant stream of homophobic, Islamophobic, and otherwise racist rhetoric which is spewed by his supporters. Jeremy Christian made many death threats against anti-fascist activists, which always found good company with the other attendees of Gibson's rallies. We oppose the normalization of these violent fascist politics and will work in solidarity with our communities to ensure it is not allowed to continue in Portland.

Baked Alaska

Tim Gionet, aka Baked Alaska, is a failed rapper that gravitated to the fascist right, once working for Milo Yiannopoulos, and eventually radicalizing to the point of adopting a number of anti-semitic slogans and memes that got him banned from an alt-right event organized by Mike Cernovich, celebrating the presidential election of Donald Trump.

Kyle Chapman

Kyle Chapman is an alt-right celebrity whose primary claim to fame is hitting a protester with a stick. He now claims to be starting a group called The Fraternal Order of Alt-Knights, with the aim of traveling around the country to start fights with more protesters.

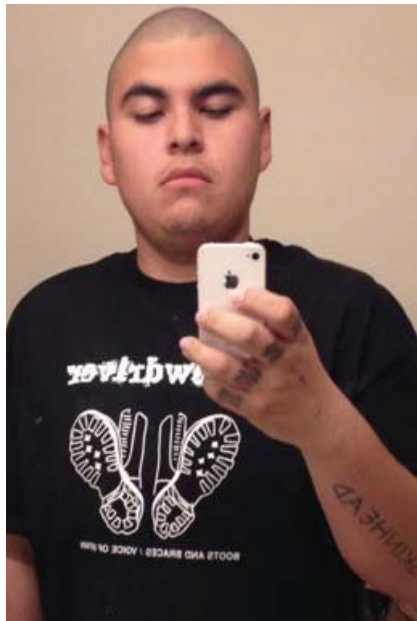

Raul Gonzalez

Raul Gonzalez is an active neo-Nazi Skinhead from Hillsboro, Oregon. Despite being Latino, Raul believes in national socialism, and runs with other well-known neo-Nazi Skinheads. Raul has been seen at “free speech” and pro-Trump rallies, and recently attended the 2017 Portland May Day rally, where he attempted to provoke attendees. On May Day, he appeared to be with the folks from CSC media (Common Sense Conservative media), who have also been at Joey Gibson’s rallies. In the right picture Raul’s SS bolt patches can be seen on his flight jacket. In the picture below, Raul can be seen wearing a Skrewdriver shirt; Skrewdriver is a now-defunct, world-famous White Power band.

Street Preachers

The Street Preachers are known for screaming bigoted hate throughout Portland's streets on megaphones. The group is anti-LGBT, anti-Muslim, and has shown up at a church in the Portland area to threaten immigrants. Joey Gibson has himself admitted that they make a lot of people uncomfortable at his rallies, and yet he continues to invite them to his events, including them in his publicity graphics.

Jake Frank / Jacob von Ott

Jake Von Ott (aka Jake Frank, Jacob Ott) was seen putting up fascist stickers as part of Joey Gibson's April 29th Free Speech march. Jake is the Oregon Coordinator of the fascist and white nationalist group Identity Europa, which focuses on recruiting students at universities along fascist white power lines. He has specifically stated that it is part of his strategy to infiltrate right-wing events for the purpose of recruitment. To the right Jake is seen shaking hands with Jeremy Christian.



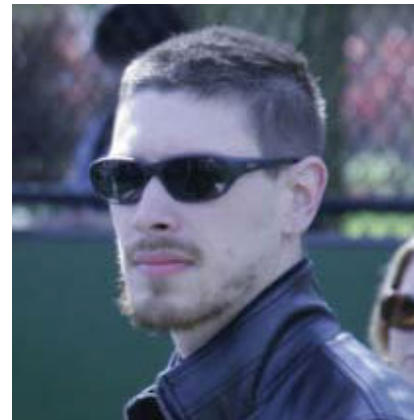

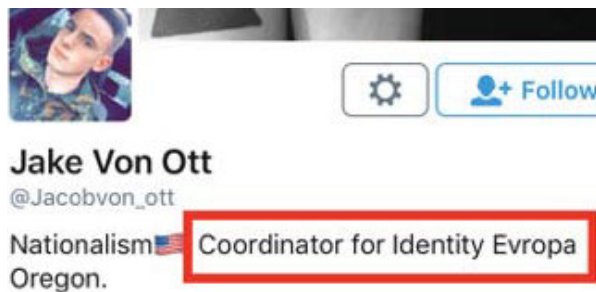

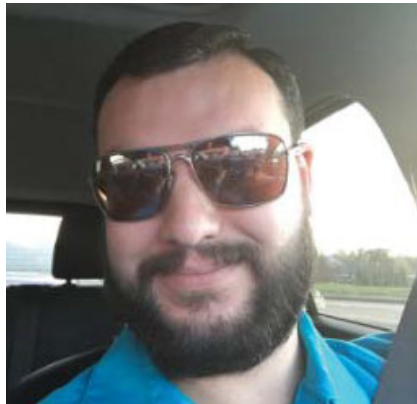
III%

The III% is a militia group, related to the Oathkeepers. These groups follow the tradition of anti-governmental armed groups from the 1990s and earlier. But without a set membership structure, anyone can buy a few stickers and patches online, and begin calling themselves part of the III%. Even though this group claims to be open to people of all races and creeds, the lack of firm organization means that all kinds of white supremacists and bigots have joined up. Many Washington and Oregon III% members have volunteered to do “security” for Joey Gibson’s events and other rallies. In the past, they have come armed and protected white supremacists like Jacob Von Ott, Steven Shane Howard, and more.

Audina Wharton

Audina is a neo-Nazi living in Washington who plans on attending the June 4th rally, and has been active on social media, chatting with other attendees of Joey Gibson's events. She has close family members active in white nationalist prison gangs, and her Facebook friends list is a who's who of well-known violent neo-Nazi skinheads (boneheads) from American Front, Hammerskins/PNW Wolfpack, Volksfront, and other groups like Cascade Legion, Wolves of Vinland, and more.

Proud Boys

The Proud Boys are a gang of white supremacist brawlers. Started by Gavin McInnes, the group spends a lot of time denying that they are racist, but they believe in preventing white western culture from being “diluted,” and the enforcement of radically patriarchal values. Their organization is like a weak frat. They are supposed to be “beat-in” to the gang, but these beat-ins, during which they are supposed to name five breakfast cereals, look more like tickle fights. Be that as it may, do not underestimate them, as they are likely to be armed and looking for a fight.

Jeff Bohnenkamp

Jeff is a well-known neo-Nazi in the Portland area, and considered to be quite violent. His occupation on his Facebook is listed as Gasser at Auschwitz. There's not really a lot more to point out here. Jeff runs with people from various white power groups, is covered in white power tattoos and is good friends with Raul Gonzalez, one of the previously mentioned National Socialists.



“Germany”

This balded-headed, bearded fellow wearing the Germany shirt was described to be spouting racist propaganda by Portland Mercury reporter Doug Brown:



It should also be noted that there were a number of open white nationalists in the crowd, including one wearing a ‘Germany’ shirt who was enthusiastically ranting about “white genocide” in South Africa and his desire to have all white people in South Africa move to America because Black people, he said, are ‘naturally cannibals.’”

“Germany” was seen at Joey Gibson’s 4/29 rally, chatting amicably with other alt-right attendees.

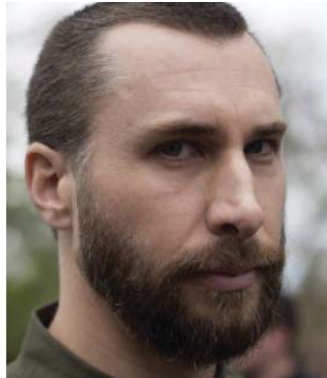

Gasser at Aushwitz Concentration Camp

“Fashy Chad”

This fellow, who has previously self-identified as “Chad” to journalists (though this is not likely his real name), was at the 4/29 rally spoiling for a fight, decked out in a baseball helmet and MMA fighting gloves (to protect his delicate Nazi knuckles). But we’ve seen those hands before, sieg heiling with other Nazis at the house of well-known Eugene-area fascist Jimmy Marr on April 24th. He also showed up to the University of Oregon’s campus in Eugene with Marr on Hitler’s birthday, and also was with him recently harassing activists in Corvallis.



Brian Fife

Brian Fife is a livestreamer that has openly supported accused murderer, white supremacist Jeremy Christian. He has also attacked activists at protests such as on May 1 in downtown Portland.



Steven Shane Howard

Steven Shane Howard refers to himself as the Grand Wizard of the North Mississippi White Knights of the KKK, and has previously been involved with the National Socialist Movement (NSM). He moved to Vancouver, WA late last year and was seen accosting protesters at the Lake Oswego Trump rally, which he attended with his neo-Nazi friend Ray Schneider. Schneider became very violent when Howard was confronted for his affiliations with the Klan and NSM and began giving Nazi salutes and screaming that he supported his local Klan.



“Goy Helmet”

This man we’ve nicknamed “Goy Helmet” was seen at Joey Gibson’s 82nd Avenue rally. He was forced to remove his “parteiadler” Nazi pin by Trump supporters, as that was apparently a little too obvious even for them. But because his “goy” helmet was a little more obscure, he was allowed to continue wearing that through the protest, marching alongside his other White Supremacist buddies. “Goy Helmet” has been seen at a number of pro-Trump events in the Portland metro area.



Judy and Jimmy Marr

An unfortunately-well-known shrill neo-nazi duo living in Springfield OR, Jimmy's main feats of activism tend toward uninvited bagpipe performances while wearing racist sandwich boards, as well as cruising the I-5 corridor in a pickup truck decorated with giant swastikas. Marr and his crew of young nazi dupes are also responsible for multiple recent freeway overpass banner-drops featuring risible neo-nazi canards on "white genocide" and other nonsense. Recently Marr has been making occasional trips to Portland, Corvallis, and Eugene, OR (specifically the UO campus) to yowl on bagpipes & irritate local students and other working class people with his obnoxious nazi proselytizing. Previous & ongoing affiliations have included the holocaust-denying "Pacifica Forum", the National Socialist Movement, and the abor-



tive all-white dipshit-hamlet of Leith, ND. Judy has been seen at multiple of Jimmy's regrettable bagpipe performances and is pictured above throwing a nazi salute. They live at 1321 G St. Springfield, OR 97477.
