Al sinds november 1977 is het Fort van Sjakoo gevestigd aan de Jodenbreestraat 24. Dit pand werd in 1975 gekraakt uit protest tegen de sloop voor een kantoorpand. Het werd door de krakers bewoonbaar gemaakt en op de benedenverdieping werd een boekwinkel ingericht. Het verzet van de krakers was succesvol: het pand werd niet gesloopt. In de jaren tachtig kocht de gemeente het pand

voor een habbekrats van een speculant en de bewoners en de boekwinkel werden huurders. Het Woningbedrijf Amsterdam was toen nog van de gemeente en kreeg zo het pand in haar bezit.

Ondertussen wordt het Fort al ruim 36 jaar vol enthousiasme draaiende gehouden door een wisselend collectief van vrijwillig(st)ers. Om principiële redenen heeft het Fort nooit afhankelijk willen zijn van overheidssubsidies of loonarbeid en tot op heden heeft het altijd kostendekkend weten te draaien. De doelstelling van het Fort is niet het maken van winst, maar het beschikbaar stellen van allerlei vormen van informatie die je elders niet zo snel vindt en het aanwakkeren van subversieve ideeën. De collectie van het Fort bestaat uit een breed scala aan radicaal linkse, maatschappijkritische, avant-gardistische, artistieke, opruiende, curieuze, milieuvriendelijke en anderszins belangwekkende publicaties waar je in de reguliere boekwinkel meestal vergeefs naar zoekt. Het vormt een distributiepunt voor allerlei in zelfbeheer uitgebrachte publicaties, muziek van kleine labels, T-shirts, opnaaiers enz. Mensen uit het hele land en ook uit de rest van de wereld komen er langs en vinden er niet zelden dingen waar ze elders tevergeefs naar hebben gezocht.

Sinds eind januari 2004 is Het Fort van Sjakoo, na een heftige huurstrijd, eigenaar van de eigen winkelruimte geworden. Met de steun van mensen uit het hele land hebben we het pand kunnen aankopen. Hiermee is voor wat betreft de huur het voortbestaan van het Fort van Sjakoo voor onbepaalde tijd veiliggesteld. Uiteraard is de aankoop geen oplossing voor het probleem van de 'gentrification' van de Europese steden.

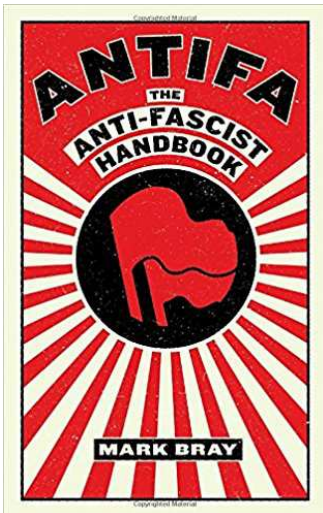

Before the election of Donald Trump the world was already speeding toward climate catastrophe. Now President Trump has jammed his foot on the global warming accelerator. Is there any way for the rest of us to put on the brakes? Climate insurgency is a strategy for using people power to realize our common interest in protecting the climate. It uses mass, global, nonviolent action to challenge the legitimacy of public and corporate officials who are perpetrating climate destruction. A global climate insurgency has already begun. As long as there has been fascism, there has been anti-fascism — also known as “antifa.” Born out of resistance to Mussolini and Hitler in Europe during the 1920s and '30s, the antifa movement has suddenly burst into the headlines amidst opposition to the Trump administration and the alt-right. They could

be seen in news reports, clad all in black with balaclavas covering their faces, fighting police at the presidential inauguration, and on California college campuses protesting right-wing speakers ... Simply, antifa aims to deny fascists the opportunity to promote their oppressive politics — by any means necessary. Critics say shutting down political adversaries is anti-democratic; antifa adherents argue that the horrors of fascism must never be allowed the slightest chance to triumph again. In a smart and gripping investigation, historian and former Occupy Wall Street organizer Mark Bray provides a one-of-a-kind look inside the movement, including a detailed survey of its history from its origins to the present day — the first transnational history of postwar anti-fascism in English. Based on interviews with anti-fascists from around the world, Antifa details the tactics of the movement and the philosophy behind it, offering insight into the growing but little understood resistance fighting back against the alt-right.

In the past few decades, urban riots have erupted in democracies across the world. While high profile politicians often react by condemning protestors' actions and passing crackdown measures, urban studies professor Mustafa Dikec shows how these revolts are in fact rooted in exclusions and genuine grievances which our democracies are failing to address. In this eye-opening study, he argues that global revolts may be sparked by a particular police or government action but nonetheless are expressions of much longer and deep seated rage accumulated through hardship and injustices that have become routine. Increasingly recognized as an expert on urban unrest, Dikec examines urban revolts in the United States, United Kingdom, France, Sweden, Greece, and Turkey and, in a sweeping and engaging account, makes it clear that change is only possible if we address the failures of democratic systems and rethink the established practices of policing and political decision-making.

Digital communication and social media have taken over our lives. In this contrarian reflection on digitized life, Byung-Chul Han counters the cheerleaders for Twitter revolutions and Facebook activism by arguing that digital communication is in fact responsible for the disintegration of community and public space and is slowly eroding any possibility for real political action and meaningful political discourse. In the predigital, analog era, by the time an angry letter to the editor had been composed, mailed, and received, the immediate agitation had passed. Today, digital communication enables instantaneous, impulsive reaction, meant to express and stir up outrage on the spot. “The shitstorm,” writes Han, “represents an authentic phenomenon of digital communication.” Meanwhile, the public, the senders and receivers of these communications have become a digital swarm—not a mass, or a crowd, or Negri and Hardt's antiquated notion of a “multitude,” but a set of isolated individuals incapable of forming a “we,” incapable of calling dominant power relations into question, incapable of formulating a future because of an obsession with the present. The digital swarm is a fragmented entity that can focus on individual persons only in order to make them an object of scandal. Han, one of the most widely read philosophers in Europe today, describes a society in which information has overrun thought, in which the same algorithms are employed by Facebook, the stock market,



and the intelligence services. Democracy is under threat because digital communication has made freedom and control indistinguishable. Big Brother has been succeeded by Big Data.

As Americans take to the streets in record numbers to resist the presidency of Donald Trump, L.A. Kauffman's timely, trenchant history of protest offers unique insights into how past movements have won victories in times of crisis and backlash and how they can be most effective today. This deeply researched account, twenty-five years in the making, traces the evolution of disruptive protest since the Sixties to tell a larger story about the reshaping of the American left. Kauffman, a longtime grassroots organizer, examines how movements from ACT UP to Occupy Wall Street to Black Lives Matter have used disruptive tactics to catalyze change despite long odds. Kauffman's lively and elegant history is propelled by hundreds of candid interviews conducted over a span of decades. Direct Action showcases the voices of key players in an array of movements – environmentalist, anti-nuclear, anti-apartheid, feminist, LGBTQ, anti-globalization, racial-justice, anti-war, and more – across an era when American politics shifted to the right, and a constellation of decentralized issue- and identity-based movements supplanted the older ideal of a single, unified left. Now, as protest movements again take on a central and urgent political role, Kauffman's history offers both striking lessons for the current moment and an unparalleled overview of the landscape of recent activism. 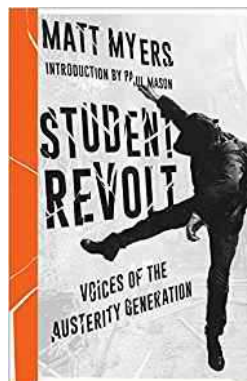

Behind the smiling faces of cashiers, wait staff, and workers of all sorts, a war is going on, usually without the knowledge of official political and labor organizations. Guerrillas of Desire begins with a provocation: The Left is wrong. It's historical and current strategies are too-often based on the assumption that working and poor people are unorganized, acquiescent to systems of domination, or simply uninterested in building a new world. The fact is, as C.L.R. James has noted, they "are rebelling every day in ways of their own invention": pilfering, sabotaging, faking illnesses, squatting, fleeing, and counter-strategizing. Kevin Van Meter maps these undercurrents, documenting the history of everyday resistance under slavery, in peasant life, and throughout modern capitalism, while showing that it remains an important factor in revolution and something radicals of all stripes must understand.

Geschichte. Nicht nur in Berlin, Hamburg, Frankfurt, Köln, Freiburg und Zürich tobte seit den 1970er Jahren der Häuserkampf. Kai Sichtermann, Gründungsmitglied der legendären Band Ton Steine Scherben, war mittendrin. 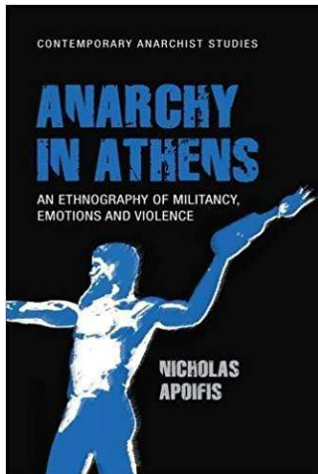

 'The Autonomous City' is a popular history of squatting in Europe and North America. Drawing on extensive archival research, it retraces the struggle for housing in cities such as Amsterdam, Berlin, Copenhagen, Detroit, Hamburg, London, Madrid, Milan, New York, and Vancouver. It looks at the organization of alternative forms of housing—from Copenhagen's Christiania 'Free Town' to the Lower East Side of Manhattan—as well as the official response, including the recent criminalization of squatting, the brutal eviction of squatters and their widespread vilification. As a result, Alexander Vasudevan argues how, through a shared history of political action, community organization and collective living, squatting has become a way to reimagine and reclaim the city. It documents the actions adopted by squatters as an alternative to housing precarity, rampant property speculation and the negative effects of urban redevelopment and regeneration. In so doing, the book challenges the dominant cartography of the 'neo-liberal city' and concludes that we must, more than ever,

reanimate and remake the city as a site of radical social transformation.

The Athenian anarchist and anti-authoritarian milieu's public protests and battles against the Greek state, police and other capitalist institutions are prolific and highly visible. Away from the intensity of the street-protests and the glare of mainstream media,

however, its militants implement anarchist practices whose outcomes are less visible. They are feeding the hungry and poor, protecting migrants from fascist beatings and trying to carve out an autonomous political, social and cultural space. Activists within this movement share politics centred on hostility to the capitalist state and all forms of domination, hierarchy and discrimination. Based on extensive ethnographic fieldwork amongst Athenian anarchists and anti-authoritarians, *Anarchy in Athens* unravels the internal complexities within this milieu and provides a better understanding of the forces that give the space its shape.

De Franse schrijver Octave Mirbeau (1854-1917) overleed honderd jaar geleden. In Frankrijk worden gebruikelijk rond zo'n moment de schijnwerpers op een culturele figuur gezet. Nu niet. Mirbeau vertolkt namelijk in zijn werk – verhalen, toneelstukken – anarchistische denkbeelden. Het werk van Mirbeau is in vele talen vertaald, ook in het Nederlands. Dick Gevers die de laatste jaren met zijn anarchistische Uitgeverij Iris meerdere noch immer actuele teksten van Mirbeau vertaald uitgaf, stelde deze AS-special samen. Met bijdragen van Martin Smit ('Octave Mirbeau, literair anarchist'), Dick Gevers ('Anarchistisch theater' en 'Octave Mirbeau en Jean Grave' en de biografische schets 'Octave Mirbeau, leven en werk') en een vertaling van het verhaal 'De bonte koe' van Mirbeau. Tevens tref je de gebruikelijke rubrieken en boekbesprekingen aan, naast gedichten. Mikhail Bakunin was a propagator of Anarchistic Socialism and an active promoter of the International Workers' Association (IWA). He argued for International workers' solidarity, change involving rural and industrial workers, and a Libertarian or Anarchist form of Socialism with federated accountable democratic organisations responsible to the grassroots, rather than hierarchical state structures. He rejected electoral politics that made working people serve the interest of middle- and upper-class professional politicians. This book brings together a selection of texts: letters, a lecture, newspaper articles, finished and unfinished works. Continuing with an account of the 1970s' leaks that revealed how the FBI and CIA kept tabs on anti-Vietnam War protestors, he assesses the reform impulse of this era - an impulse that began in America and only gradually spread to Britain. The end of the Cold War further at the end of the 1980s then undermined confidence in the need for state surveillance still further, but it was to return with a vengeance after 9/11. What emerges is a story in which governments habitually abuse their surveillance powers once granted, demonstrating the need for proper controls in this area. But, as Jeffreys-Jones makes clear, this is not simply a story of the Orwellian state. While private sector firms have sometimes acted as a brake on surveillance by the state (particularly in the electronic era), they have also often engaged in dubious surveillance practices of their own. Oversight and regulation, he argues, therefore need to be universal and not simply concentrate on the threat to the individual posed by the agencies of government.

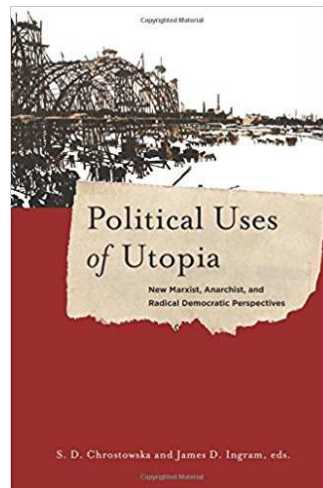

The items selected, several of them previously unpublished, also reflect the broad range of topics addressed in Churchill's scholarship, from the fallacies of archeological/anthropological orthodoxy like the Bering Strait migration hypothesis and the insistence of "cannibologists" that American Indians were traditionally man-eaters, to cinematic degradations of native people by Hollywood, the historical and ongoing genocide of North America's native peoples, questions of American Indian identity, and the systematic distortion of political and legal history by reactionary scholars as a means of denying the realities of U.S.-Indian relations. Also included are both the initial "stream-of-consciousness" version of Churchill's famous—or notorious—"little Eichmanns" opinion piece analyzing the causes of the attacks on 9/11, as well as the counterpart essay in which his argument was fully developed, which garnered honorable mention for the 2004 Gustavus Myers Award for best writing on human rights. Less typical of Churchill's oeuvre is an essay commemorating the passing of Cherokee anthropologist Robert K. Thomas, and another on that of Yankton Sioux legal scholar and theologian Vine Deloria, Jr., to each of whom he acknowledges a deep intellectual debt. More unusual still is his moving and profoundly personal effort to come to grips with the life and death of his late wife, Leah Renae Kelly, thereby illuminating in very human terms the grim and lasting effects of Canada's residential schools upon the country's indigenous peoples.

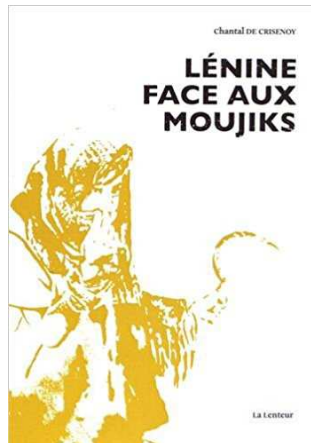

Im Gefängnis, nicht wissend, ob seine Aufzeichnungen jemals Leser finden würden, rechnete er nicht nur mit den Militärs des Landes, sondern auch mit der Sozialdemokratie ab. Dabei zeigt das sogenannte Gefängnistagebuch die Vielschichtigkeit der Person Eisners, der seine Gedanken der Nachwelt übermittelte. 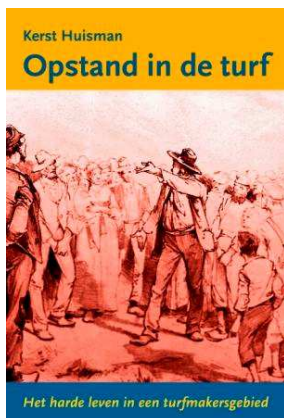

Between the winter of 1936 and the autumn of 1938, approximately three quarters of a million Soviet citizens were subject to summary execution. More than a million others were sentenced to lengthy terms in labour camps. Commonly known as 'Stalin's Great Terror', it is also among the most misunderstood moments in the history of the twentieth century. The Terror gutted the ranks of factory directors and engineers after three years in which all major plan targets were met. It raged through the armed forces on the eve of the Nazi invasion. The wholesale slaughter of party and state officials was in danger of making the Soviet state ungovernable. The majority of these victims of state repression in this period were accused of participating in counter-revolutionary conspiracies. Almost without exception, there was no substance to the claims and no material evidence to support them. By the time the terror was brought to a close, most of its victims were ordinary Soviet citizens for whom 'counter-revolution' was an unfathomable abstraction. In short, the Terror was wholly destructive, not merely in terms of the incalculable human cost, but also in terms of the interests of the Soviet leaders, principally Joseph Stalin, who directed and managed it. 'The Great Fear' presents a new and original explanation of Stalin's Terror based on intelligence materials in Russian archives. It shows how Soviet leaders developed a grossly exaggerated fear of conspiracy and foreign invasion and lashed out at enemies largely of their own making.

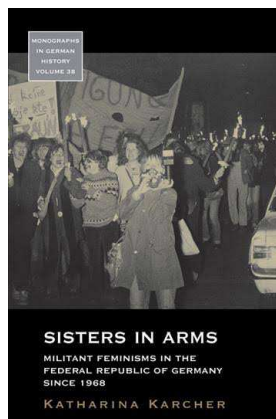

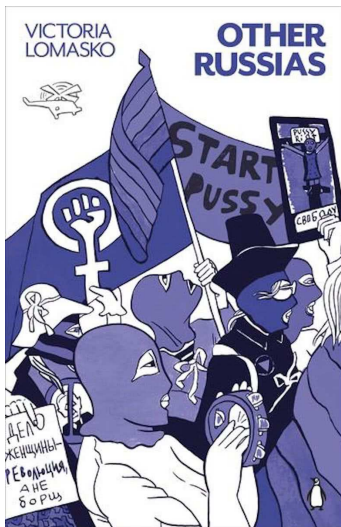

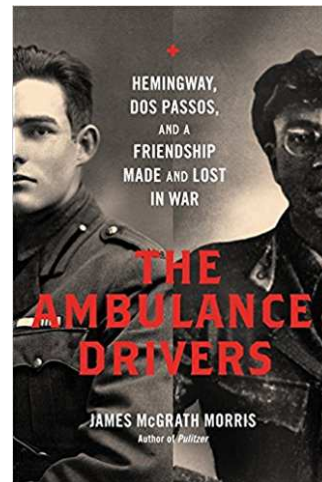

Née en 1902, Eugénie Markon est fille de la bourgeoisie juive intellectuelle de Péetrograd. Elle dénonce le coup d'État bolchevique et prend parti pour les insurgés de Cronstadt et les anarchistes en exil. Elle épouse le poète anarchiste futuriste Alexandre Iaroslavski. Après l'arrestation de celui-ci, elle fréquente les bas-fonds de Péetrograd et de Moscou et pratique le vol pour survivre. Elle veut faire évader son mari mais elle est internée à son tour dans les îles Solovki, un archipel de la mer Blanche, annonciateur du Goulag. Elle refuse le travail forcé, insulte ses gardiens et ses bourreaux. Quelques mois avant son exécution (1931), elle écrit son autobiographie. Dès l'adolescence, Evguénia, née en 1902, enfant de la bourgeoisie intellectuelle juive de Saint-Pétersbourg, happée par la révolution de 1917 et les espoirs qu'elle suscite, forme le projet de travailler en usine. Rapidement -devenue militante anarchiste, vendeuse de journaux à Moscou, elle s'impose une -discipline de fer, mange peu, abandonne ses études de philosophie pour partager le sort des plus pauvres et vivre dans la clandestinité. Mais vite, elle comprend que les bolcheviques ont mis la révolution « sous tutelle » pour en faire un régime figé et policier et qu'ils sont ainsi les vrais contre-révolutionnaires. Mariée au poète Alexandre Iaroslavski, Evguénia va mener une vie aventureuse, fera des conférences à travers l'Union soviétique, ira à Berlin, à Paris et, revenue à Moscou, vivra parmi les voleurs et les prostituées, la pègre et la classe des « va-nu-pieds » constituant la seule classe sociale qui, selon elle, mène les vraies révoltes contre la société. Diseuse de bonne aventure, voleuse elle-même — elle détaille avec précision ses modes opératoires —, animée d'une haine féroce à l'égard des tchékistes, elle sera plusieurs fois arrêtée par la Guépéou, la police d'Etat, et retrouvera, à peine libérée, le monde de la rue, avant d'être de nouveau incarcérée puis

déportée en Sibérie. Elle sera exécutée en 1931, à l'âge de 29 ans, dans le camp des îles Solovki (1) .

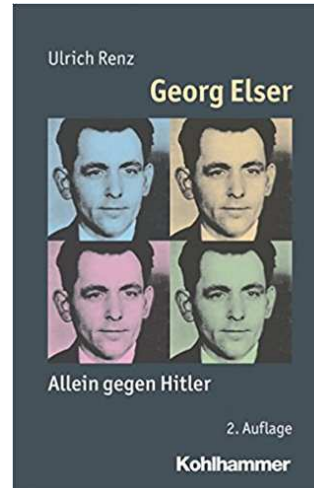

In 1970, nine members of a Japanese New Left group called the Red Army Faction hijacked a domestic airliner to North Korea with dreams of acquiring the military training to bring about a revolution in Japan. The North Korean government accepted the hijackers—who became known in the media as the Yodogō group, based on the name of the hijacked plane—and two years later they announced their conversion to juče, North Korea's new political ideology. Little was heard from the exiles until 1988, when a member of Yodogō was unexpectedly arrested in Japan, and communications with the group opened up in the context of his trial. As a former Red Army Faction member, journalist Kōji Takazawa made several trips to North Korea, re-established his ties to the group's leader Takamaro Tamiya, and helped to publish the group's writings in Japan. After Kim Il Sung revealed that Yodogō members had Japanese wives, Takazawa published a book of interviews with the women, but in the process became suspicious about the romantic stories they told. He also wondered about the members who were missing, and learned more details in long, private conversations with Tamiya. After Tamiya's sudden death in 1995, Takazawa launched his own investigation of what the group had actually been doing for two decades, even traveling to Europe to follow traces there. An example of superb investigative journalism, *Destiny: The Secret Operations of the Yodogō Exiles* offers Kōji Takazawa's powerful story of how he exposed the Yodogō group's involvement in the kidnapping and luring of several young Japanese to North Korea, as well as the truth behind their Japanese wives' presence in the country. Takazawa's careful research was validated in 2002, when the North Korean government publicly acknowledged it had kidnapped thirteen Japanese citizens during the 1970s and 1980s, including three people whom Takazawa had connected to the Yodogō hijackers. Embedded in his pursuit toward what truly happened to the Yodogō members is Takazawa's personal reflection of the 1970s, a decade when radical student activism swept Japan, and what it meant to those whose lives were forever changed.

Niet iedereen werd vrijwillig kampbewaker; Tsjistjakov werd gedwongen. Het dagboek eindigt abrupt, waarschijnlijk met de arrestatie van hemzelf. De poëtische beschrijvingen van het Siberische landschap worden afgewisseld met die van het harde bestaan in het kamp en met gedachten over het steeds grotere verlangen om het kamp te verlaten. Tsjistjakov maakt ons niet alleen deelgenoot van het leven in een kamp, hij weet het aan de vergetelheid te ontrukken.

Das Schweigen der Waffen 1945 bedeutete auf deutschem Boden nicht nur das Ende der NS-Herrschaft zugleich markiert das Weltkriegsende den Beginn einer schließlich erbitterten Feindschaft der vormaligen Verbündeten Sowjetunion und Westalliierte. Alexander Solschenizyn oder Warlam Schalamow haben den GULag, das zur Sowjetunion von Anfang an gehörige Lagersystem, literarisch gültig verarbeitet, den Verlust jeglicher Menschenrechte seiner Insassen gegeißelt und die gnadenlose Ausbeutung der menschlichen Arbeitskraft, die oft mit dem Tod endete, verurteilt.<sup>2</sup> Aber auch unter diesen apokalyptischen Lebensbedingungen blieb jenseits aller Unterdrückung ein starker Freiheitswille der Gefangenen erhalten. Nach dem Tod Stalins im März 1953 schöpften diese Gepeinigten neue Hoffnung und neuen Mut. Schon bald nach dem Arbeiteraufstand vom 17. Juni 1953 in der DDR und der Verhaftung des scheinbar allmächtigen Innenministers und Geheimdienstchefs Berija verweigerten beispielsweise rund 15.000 Sklavenarbeiter im nördlich des Polarkreises gelegenen Lager Workuta die Zwangsarbeit. Sie forderten die Überprüfung der SMT-Urteile und ihre Freilassung. Im Lager 10, Schacht 29, statuierte Armeegeneral Maslennikow ein Exempel: Geheimdienst-Truppen des MGB schossen am 1. August 1953 auf die wehrlosen Gefangenen aus über 20 Nationen. 64 Tote und 123 zum Teil schwer Verletzte waren die Bilanz dieses Massakers. Darüber berichtet dieses Buch in vielen Einzelheiten. <sup>1</sup> 152 deutsche Staatsbürger, die in diesem

Lager lebten, wurden 1955/56 entlassen. Sie fanden und finden sich jährlich zu einem Treffen zusammen, in dessen Zentrum stets die Mahnung zur Bewahrung der Freiheit steht. Freiheit ist für sie das zentrale verbindende Moment. Ihre Schicksale sind sämtlich bedeutsam ebenso wie die Erinnerung an jenen 1. August, zu dem der später rehabilitierte Oberleutnant der Roten Armee Boris J. Kudrjawzew schrieb: Möge dieser Tag denjenigen, die den Befehl gegeben haben, auf uns zu schießen, und denjenigen, die diesen verbrecherischen Befehl ausgeführt haben, zur Schande gereichen.

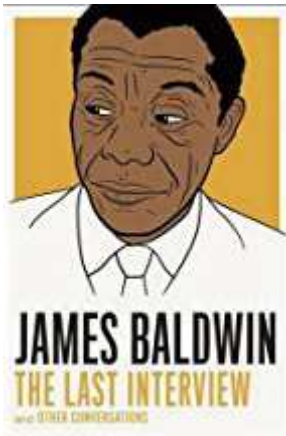

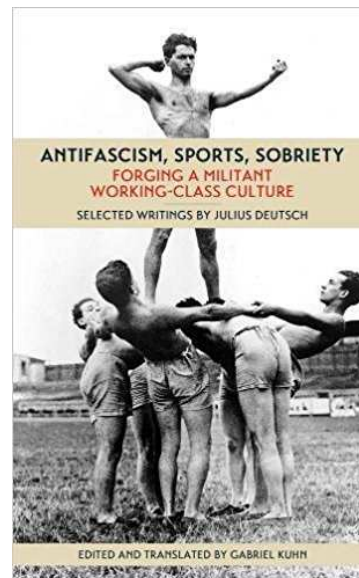

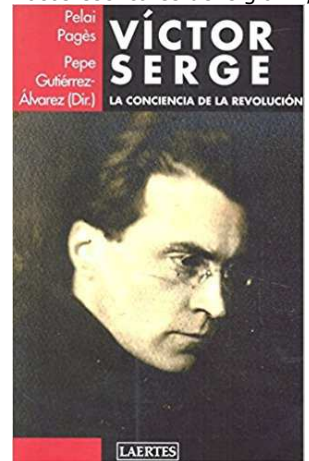

como Víctor Serge, han visto condicionada su producción literaria con tanta amplitud por el día a día de los procesos históricos que vivió, en la medida en que Serge no fue un mero espectador de la realidad social y política que le tocó vivir, sino que se implicó en ella hasta el extremo de que condicionó su vida. 'In de ban van een beter verleden' biedt een compleet overzicht van opkomst, bloei en ondergang van de fascistische politieke partijen die Nederland heeft gekend in de periode 1923-1945. Vanaf het Verbond van Actualisten (in de jaren twintig), via de Algemeene Nederlandsche Fascisten Bond van Jan Baars en het Zwart Front van Arnold Meijer (in de jaren dertig) tot de ondergang in 1945 van de NSB van Anton Mussert passeren meer dan 60 politieke partijen en partijtjes de revue. In veel gevallen uitgebreid met specifieke biografische aandacht voor de hoofdrolspelers en de media waarin zij zich profileerden. Waarom zagen in het interbellum vele tienduizenden Nederlanders zich als fascist? Want anders dan in Italië en Duitsland is het Nederlandse fascisme er nooit in geslaagd zichzelf te positioneren als een brede politiek-maatschappelijke beweging. Tot slot worden het Nederlandse en het generieke fascisme met elkaar vergeleken, met als opmerkelijke uitkomst dat de Nederlandse variant daar duidelijk van afwijkt - een tot dusver onbekend feit. 'In de ban van een beter verleden' is rijk geïllustreerd met veel voorheen onbekend beeldmateriaal van fascistische politici, activisten en politieke partijen.

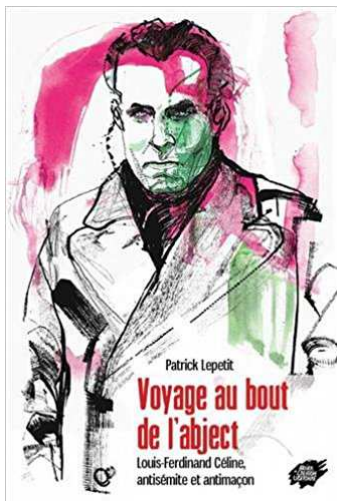

While behind bars, Rashid encountered the ideas of revolutionary Black nationalism and Marxism-Leninism, and of the people and organizations who have used and developed these ideas in previous generations, foremost amongst these being the Black Panther Party for Self-Defense. Along with other Black/New Afrikan prisoners, Rashid helped found the New Afrikan Black Panther Party-Prison Chapter, while using both his artwork and his political writings as avenues to advance the cause of liberation for all. Here, collected in book form for the first time, are Rashid's core writings as Minister of Defense of the NABPP-PC. Involving charges of conspiracy to commit violent acts, the Panther 21 trial--- the longest and most expensive in New York history--- revealed the illegal government activities which led to exile, imprisonment on false charges, and assassination of Black liberation leaders. The Liberation Support Movement was a North American solidarity organization which existed from 1968 to 1982. Marxist and anti-imperialist in orientation, they primarily sought to build support within the U.S. and Canada for African liberation movements. They built direct connections with representatives of movements from Angola, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa, Zimbabwe, and more. With their own printshop and an ambitious political program, they published dozens of pamphlets, newsletters, posters, buttons, and even record albums featuring the stories, theories, and culture of African revolutionaries. In addition they booked tours, film screenings, and collected money for direct material aid. At a time when most political groups in N. America were either focused on the domestic sphere or Vietnam, LSM brought the struggles of people from across Africa into the consciousness of the Left. For this publication, Josh MacPhee has interviewed three former members of the LSM, as well as compiled a bibliography of the groups printed output. 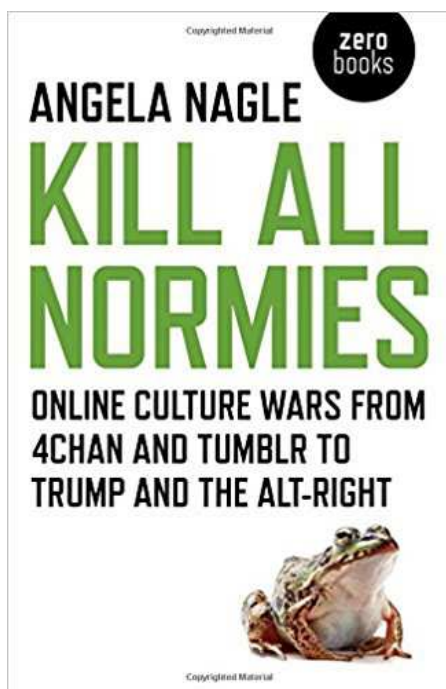

prison, exile, and bitter disappointment in the revolutions of the first half of the twentieth century. 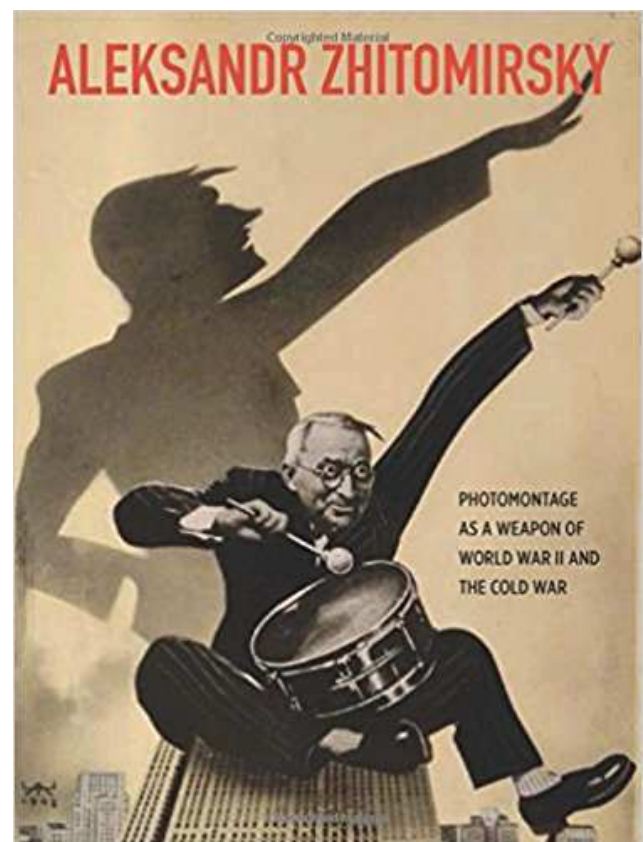

The leading Russian propaganda artist Aleksandr Zhitomirsky (1907–1993) made photomontages that were airdropped on German troops during World War II. He later worked for Pravda and other leading publications, satirizing American politics and finance from the Truman through the Reagan eras and educating his public about Egypt, South Africa, Vietnam, and Nicaragua as well. Zhitomirsky

favoured the grotesque and the eye-catching. His villainous menagerie included Reichsminister Joseph Goebbels as a distorted simian and an airborne scorpion outfitted with an Uncle Sam hat. In this comprehensive, image-driven account of Zhitomirsky's long career, Erika Wolf explores his connections to and long friendship with the German artist John Heartfield, whose work inspired his own. Wolf also examines more than 100 of Zhitomirsky's photomontages and translates excerpts from his one published book, The Art of Political Photomontage: Advice for the Artist (1983). In an era when satirical photomontage thrives on the Internet and propaganda has reasserted itself in America and Russia alike, this study of a once-prominent yet internationally undiscovered artist is more than timely.

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De Amsterdamse activist Peike werd tijdens de protesten tegen de G20-top in Hamburg juli jl opgepakt en beschuldigd van allerlei belachelijke aantijgingen op grond van tegenstrijdige verklaringen van agenten. Hij zit al sinds de G20 in juli 2017 vast in Duitsland en werd in eerste instantie veroordeeld tot twee jaar en zeven maanden gevangenisstraf. Met

Peike's vonnis wou de aartsconservatieve rechter een zero-tolerance signaal afgeven en potentiële toekomstige demonstranten tonen dat je in Hamburg niet moet komen demonstreren, want je bent bij voorbaat schuldig door het simpel feit dat je de straat op gaat. De eersten en voornaamsten die met een enorme overkill aan geweld in Hamburg hebben opgetreden waren niemand anders dan de 30.000 politieagenten. Die worden nooit ter verantwoording geroepen voor hun ongebreidelde sadistische gedrag. Peike gaat natuurlijk in hoger beroep. Hij en de andere gevangenen krijgen te maken met hevige repressie. Steun en solidariteit zijn hard nodig, want bijstand van advocaten kost in Duitsland flink wat, doordat je er geen pro-deo advocaten hebt. Vanuit de supportgroep worden benefieten, demonstraties en schrijfavonden georganiseerd. Mocht je daarnaast zelf iets willen organiseren, kan je altijd contact met ons opnemen. ## Melle, visionair schilder

Melle Oldeboerrigter (1908-1976) wordt vaak gezien als een surrealist, maar zelf noemde hij zich een visionair schilder. Het werk van Melle stelt veel mensen voor raadsels, ook deskundigen. Zijn visioenen, de verwijzingen naar zijn jeugd in de Amsterdamse armeluisbuurt Wittenburg, ondergaande schepen, talloze dieren en minutieus getekende of geschilderde planten, fallussen en vagina's. Wat hebben die te betekenen, ook afgezet tegen de tijd waarin hij leefde? Speelden ervaringen uit zijn jeugd soms een belangrijke rol? De tentoonstelling is te zien van 21 november 2017 t/m 4 maart 2018.

### Melle in Friesland

Om meer te weten te komen over zijn jonge jaren en ontwikkeling van zijn werk zet het Ferdinand Domela Nieuwenhuis Museum de deuren open voor een tentoonstelling van de kunstenaar. Het werk van Melle is hier op zijn plek. De vader van Melle was een fervent aanhanger van de sociaal-anarchist Ferdinand Domela Nieuwenhuis. Anarchistische ideeën kregen Melle en zijn beide zusters met de paplepel ingegoten. In hun puberteit werden die ideeën verder gevormd door de anarchistische jongerengroep rond het blad *De Moker*. De tekeningen die Melle voor het blad van deze groep maakte, zijn altijd in de schaduw van zijn naoorlogse werk gebleven. Dat geldt ook voor de talloze politieke tekeningen die hij in de jaren dertig maakte. Het antikolonialisme, antifascisme, pacifisme en liefde voor de natuur, die in zijn *Moker*-tijd versterkt werden, kenmerken zijn

werk van 1926 tot 1940, maar zijn nadien zeker niet verdwenen.

### Een nieuwe blik

De tentoonstelling onderzoekt specifiek wat van deze vooroorlogse standpunten terug te vinden is in het naoorlogse werk van Melle en hoe het vooroorlogse engagement na 1945 een gedaantewisseling heeft ondergaan. Daartoe wordt een greep gedaan uit het grote en gevarieerde oeuvre van de kunstenaar: tekeningen, grafiek, aquarellen, schilderijen en borduurwerken. Het vooroorlogse werk dat tot voor kort minder aandacht kreeg, is nadrukkelijk aanwezig.

In dit nummer een kritisch overzichtsartikel over de eerste jaren na 1917 en een artikel over de revolutie van 1905 hopen we toch een paar anarchistische kanttekeningen bij deze omstreden gebeurtenissen te plaatsen. Voor wie dit te karig vindt: in het volgende nummer gaan we ook nog aandacht aan dit onderwerp besteden, met artikelen over Kronstadt en Maria Nikiforova, leidster van de Zwarte Garde in Oekraïne tijdens de revolutie. Ook in dit nummer blijven we de ontwikkelingen in Syrië volgen. Wat hebben Netflix, geopolitiek en Syrische hulpverleners met elkaar te maken? Jan Bervoets ontrafelt het propagandistische schimmenspel rond de White Helmets in Aleppo. Verder hebben we een interview met leden van de International Revolutionary People's Guerrilla Forces

(IRPGF), dat in Noord-Syrië als een soort Internationale Brigade opereert en onder andere deelneemt aan het offensief om IS uit Raqqa te verdrijven. Er is natuurlijk ook weer veel aandacht voor praktisch activisme, met artikelen over demonstratietactieken, over de stand van zaken in Schinveld en over Code Rood en Ende Gelände. En verder hebben we naast verschillende kunst- en boekrecensies ook de vaste kronieken over economie, migratiestrijd en internationaal oproer en natuurlijk de thematische boekenrubriek van Het Fort van Sjakoo.
