

Submission Guidelines *The Socionomist*

1. State a cogent socionomic thesis. Support it with evidence.

2. Connect your report to socionomic research or commentary published previously.

3. Maintain a socionomic focus throughout.

4. Be engaging and informative.

5. If appropriate, make a socionomic forecast.

6. Make sure your evidence is conclusive, from reliable sources and supports precisely the claims that you make. Follow the Five Tenets of Socionomics: <u>http://www.socionomics.net/PDF/socionomic.tenets.pdf</u>

7. Avoid spelling and grammar mistakes. Refer to a dictionary and the AP Stylebook when in doubt.

8. Ensure the manuscript is free of libel, plagiarism and copyright infringement.

9. Cite all references using APA format: <u>http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/APA_style#Citation</u>

10. Keep your article between 250 and 3000 words, in English.

11. Send your submission electronically in Microsoft Word.

12. Include a short autobiographical paragraph and a "head shot"-style photo at the end of the submission. If you do not have a photo readily available, you may see whether your article is accepted before providing one.
