JIMI HENDRIX WILD BLUE ANGEL LIVE AT THE ISLE OF WIGHT

Fully re-mastered and restored in 2005 with previously unseen footage, this concert features Hendrix classics 'Purple Haze', 'Foxy Lady', 'All Along The Watchtower' as well as 'Freedom', 'Dolly Dagger' and 'In From The Storm' which Hendrix rarely performed. A dazzling vision of Jimi at the very peak of his performing career, directed by Academy Award winning director Murray Lerner.

JIMI HENDRIX ELECTRIC CHURCH

This new film highlights Jimi Hendrix's legendary July 4th 1970 performance as the headline act of America's last great rock festival. More than 500,000 people descended on Byron, Georgia to witness Jimi performing dynamic versions of his signature songs including 'Star Spangled Banner', 'Purple Haze', 'Hey Joe', 'Foxy Lady' and 'Voodoo Child (Slight Return)' and exciting new songs such as 'Freedom' and 'Straight Ahead'. Along with feature interviews, this film also establishes the significance of the festival which stood as the largest counter culture gathering in middle America.

IRON MAIDEN FLIGHT 666

Flight 666 documents the first leg of Maiden's legendary 'Somewhere Back In Time' world tour which takes them 50,000 miles around the planet playing 23 concerts on five continents in just 45 days. One of the stars of the movie is the band's customised Boeing 757, Ed Force One, which carries the band, all their crew and 12 tons of stage equipment and is piloted by Airline Captain and singer Bruce Dickinson. The movie gives a close up behind-the-scenes look at what happens on and off stage, with Maiden giving full access to a film crew for the first time ever, and contains some of the most spectacular live footage yet seen of Maiden.

Filmed in Santiago, Chile on 10th April 2011, during their spectacular 'Final Frontier' World Tour 2010 - 2011, Maiden became the first heavy rock band ever to perform at the prestigious Estadio Nacional. Playing to a packed audience of over 50,000 Chilean devotees, Maiden's spectacular live show features songs from the band's latest studio album 'The Final Frontier', which was No 1 in over 28 countries, (including the Grammy winning 'El Dorado' and the anthemic 'Coming Home'), alongside classic fan favourites such as 'The Trooper', 'The Number Of The Beast' and 'Fear Of The Dark'.

IRON MAIDEN SOMEWHERE BACK IN TIME LIVE

Filmed on the first leg of the band's historic 'Somewhere Back In Time' World Tour, which was reportedly played to an audience of more than 2 million people, Iron Maiden performed live to sellout crowds in stadiums around the world. This concert focused on the band's classic 1980's material, in particular songs from 'Powerslave', 'Somewhere In Time' and 'Seventh Son Of A Seventh Son'.

DAVID GILMOUR LIVE AT POMPEII

1 x 60'  

45 years after Pink Floyd's David Gilmour filmed 'Live At Pompeii' in the legendary Roman Amphitheatre there, he returned for two spectacular shows, part of his year-long tour in support of his No.1 album 'Rattle That Lock'. The performances were the first-ever rock concerts for an audience in the stone Roman amphitheatre, and, for two nights only, the 2,600 strong crowd stood exactly where gladiators would have fought in the first century AD. David Gilmour Live At Pompeii is an audio-visual spectacle, featuring lasers, pyrotechnics and a huge circular screen on which specially-created films complement selected songs, but paramount above all is the astonishing music and stellar performances from an all-star band. The show includes songs from throughout David's career, as well as many Pink Floyd classics, including 'One Of These Days', the only song that was also performed at the band's 1971 show. Both concerts also saw very special performances of 'The Great Gig In The Sky' from 'The Dark Side Of The Moon', which David rarely plays as a solo artist. This 60-minute performance includes highlights from both shows, filmed in 4k by director Gavin Elder. David Gilmour Live At Pompeii shows an artist at the top of his artistic game, performing incredible material with his world-class band, in a unique setting, on one very special occasion.

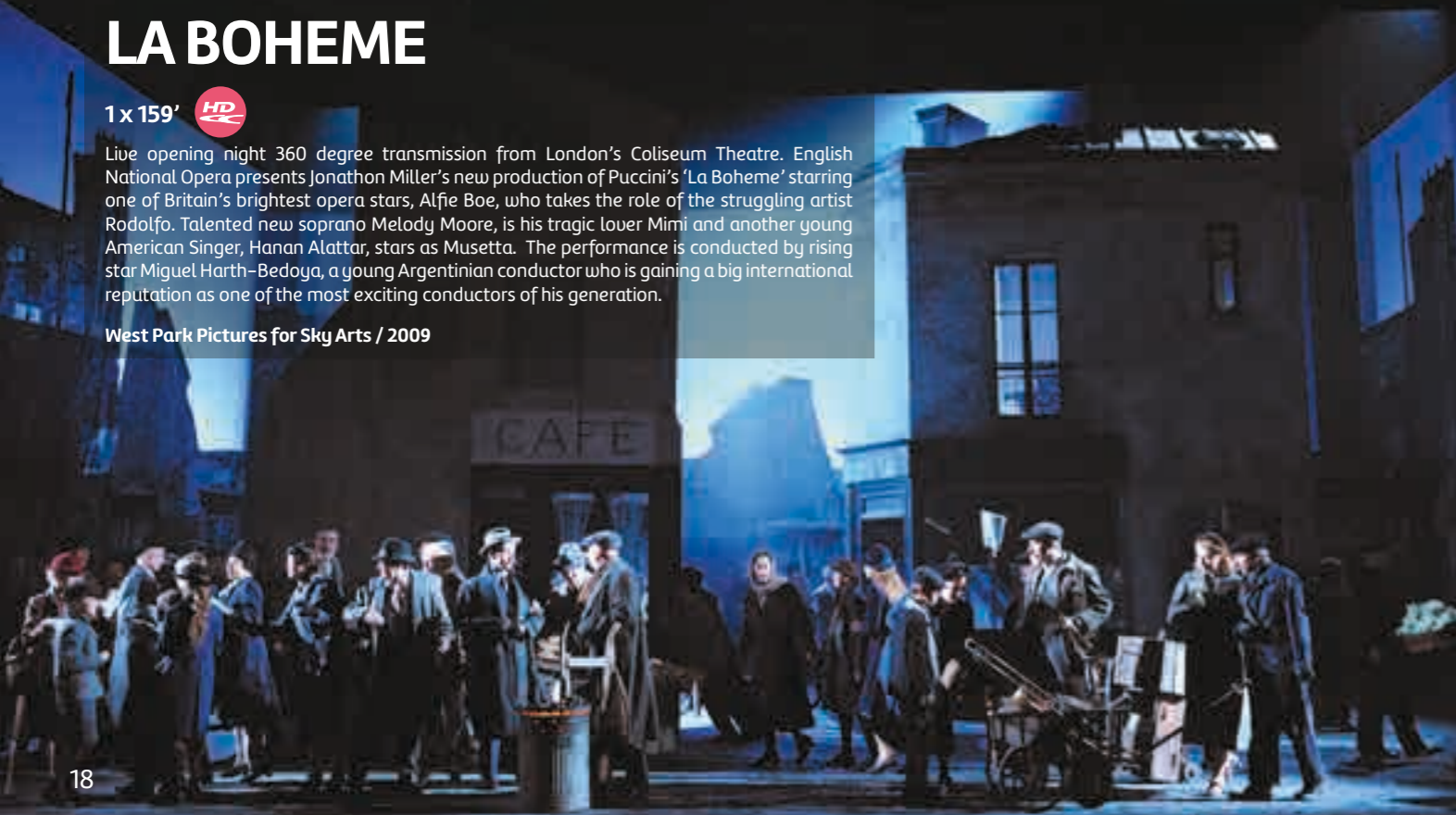

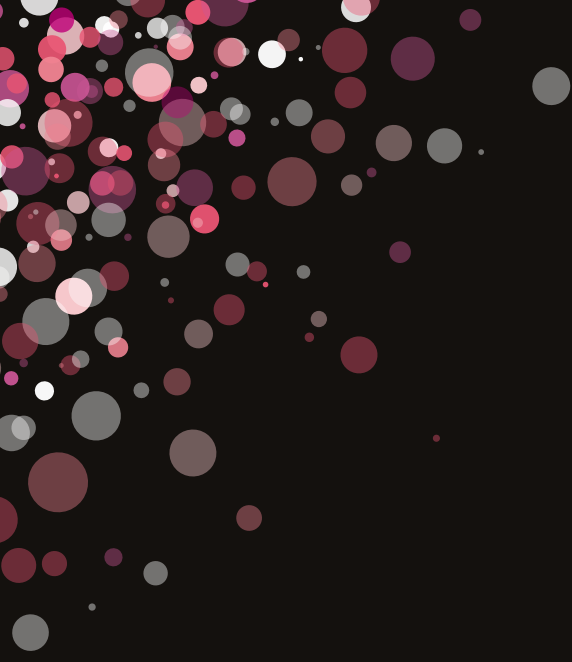
