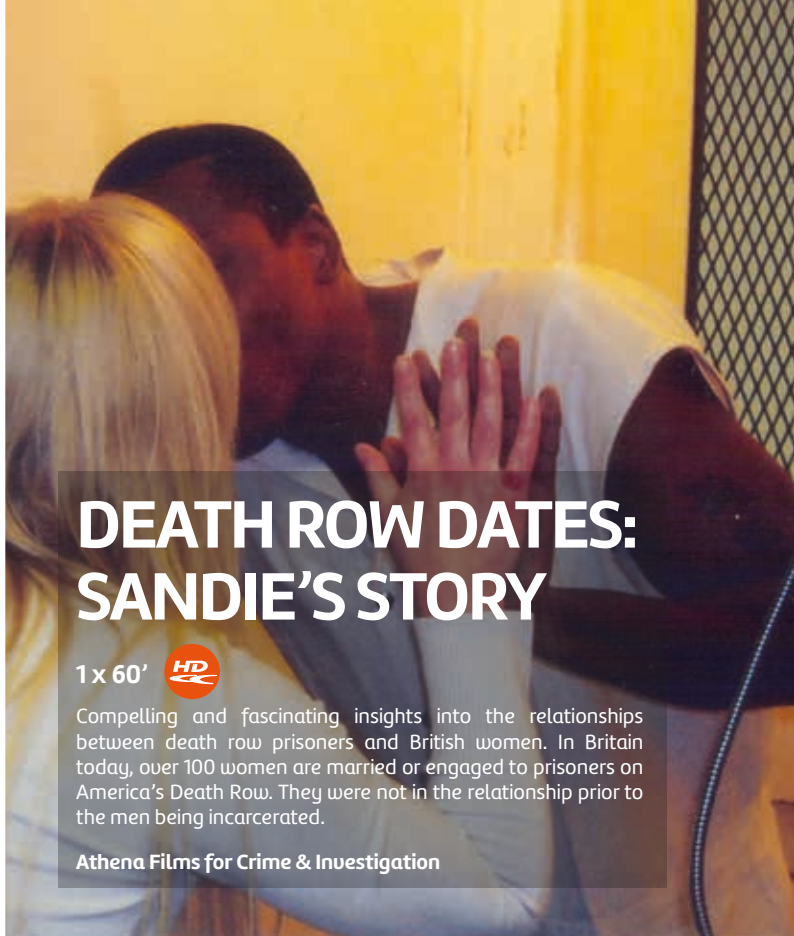

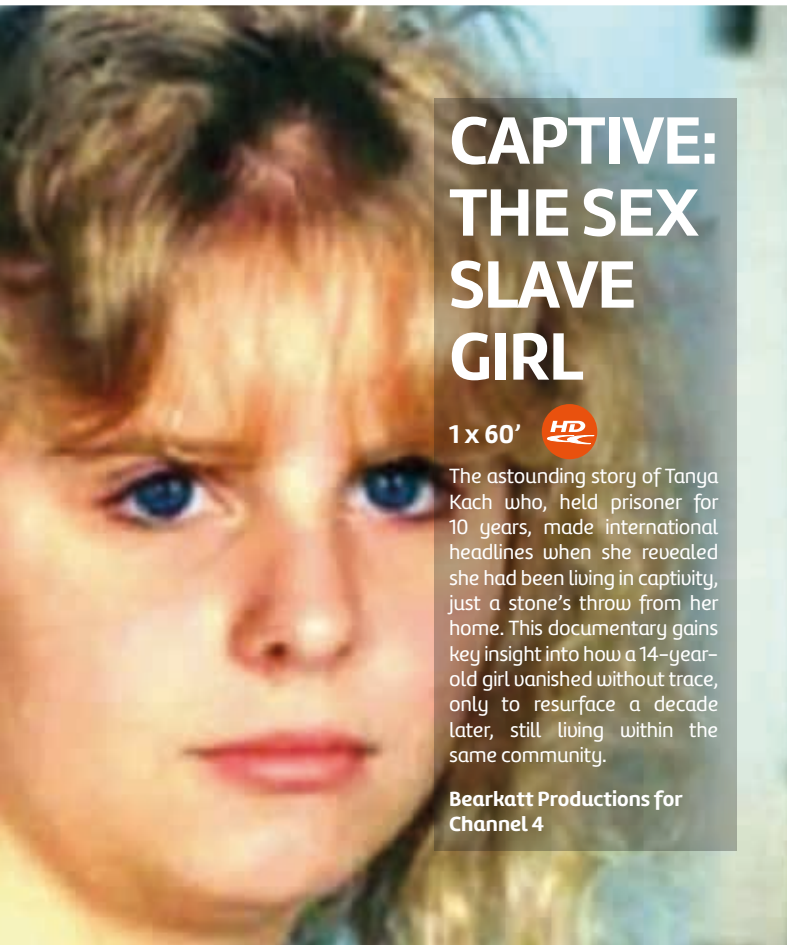

In a small South African town, Dr Wally Nell, stumbles across a sleeping drug that harnesses the ability to release hundreds of brain damaged patients from their vegetative state.

Rewire My Brain

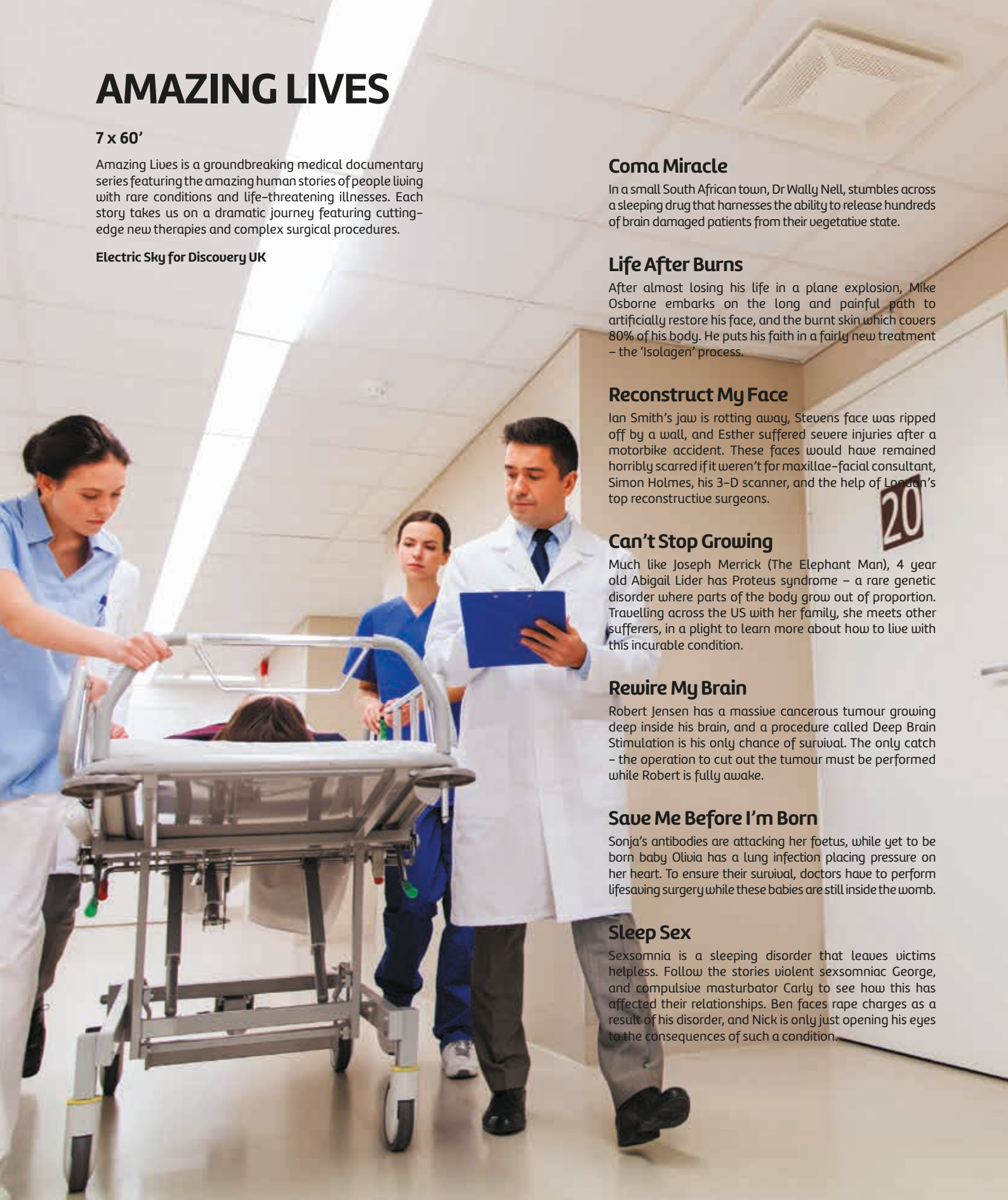
Robert Jensen has a massive cancerous tumour growing deep inside his brain, and a procedure called Deep Brain Stimulation is his only chance of survival. The only catch – the operation to cut out the tumour must be performed while Robert is fully awake.

Save Me Before I'm Born

Sonja's antibodies are attacking her foetus, while yet to be born baby Olivia has a lung infection placing pressure on her heart. To ensure their survival, doctors have to perform lifesaving surgery while these babies are still inside the womb.

Sleep Sex

Sexsomnia is a sleeping disorder that leaves victims helpless. Follow the stories violent sexsomnia George, and compulsive masturbator Carly to see how this has affected their relationships. Ben faces rape charges as a result of his disorder, and Nick is only just opening his eyes to the consequences of such a condition.

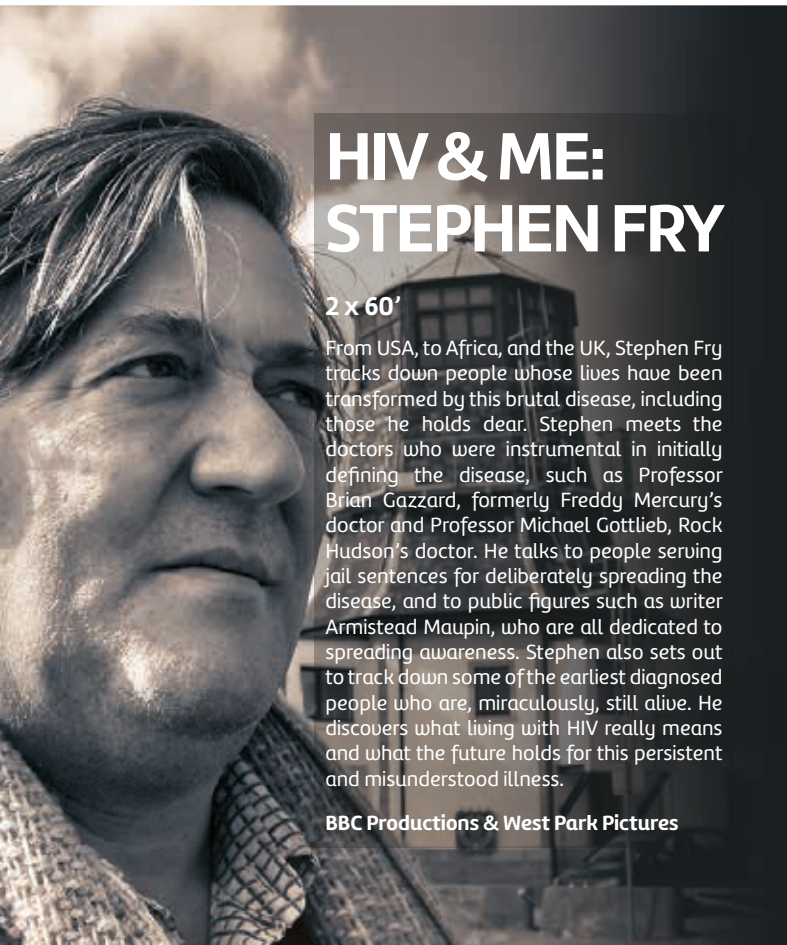
