On 1-6 August, a Master Forum of Social Volunteering, organized by the Siberian Initiative NGO and supported by Y-PEER and UNFPA, was held in the Altai Mountains. This event brought together young people from Russia and CIS representing NGOs, youth associations and foundations working in the area of youth health, HIV prevention and development of youth potential. The aim of the forum was to give young people an opportunity to share information and knowledge, participate in trainings and discussions.
