RAS (Ride Around the Sound) is a regional travel tour program. Puget Sound is home to a large and widely used public bus system. Bus travel is fast, economical, safe, and energy efficient. Once a month RAS takes riders on a tour to fun locations using the bus and sometimes other modes of public transit. Inexperienced riders "buddy up" with experienced travelers who show the new rider how to feel at ease while using the transit system.
