Circumstances:

Police were requested to attend above listed unit, neighbours were reporting a male was yelling abuse, discharging missiles & other objects from the interior out into the driveway area. Information received indicated the male was drug & alcohol affected. The unit was secured & entry was unable to be gained by police who responded. C.I.R.T & Canine units were requested by Not Relevant. Upon arrival of the first police response unit offender became silent and communication with him was only established when negotiators made contact with him. He was very agitated & abusive towards police and vented his anger by throwing various objects at police. After approximately 10 to 15 minutes he emerged carrying a knife and was hit by 3 bean bag shots discharged by security personnel. He was detained outside his unit. He was conveyed for psychiatric assessment. Debrief was conducted involving all police personnel involved in attendance at the incident.
