### Details of incident leading up to use of TASER:

Verbal dispute at above address between Not Relevant then became highly agitated upon police attendance. At this time Not Relevant has barricaded himself inside the premises Not Relevant CIRT team notified and in attendance. SOG also requested and attended shortly after. Negotiations commenced via phone between Not Relevant and Police. During negotiations Not Relevant made numerous threats to kill Not Relevant and further escalated by pouring and fighting petrol on rear yard grass before returning inside. Not Relevant then damaged front door of premises using kitchen knives and a hockey stick. During this he continually stated to negotiators he will kill Not Relevant if Police entered the premises. SOG given approval to commit the Emergency Action and entered the premises by ramming the front door.

On 12/12/2008, after an altercation with family members, police attended at Not Relevant address. Whilst arresting Not Relevant and attempting to remove him from the property a resulting altercation required five members to attempt to control Not Relevant. O/C spray was used to little or no effect combined with 30 - 40 baton strikes to the legs. Two members were injured as a result of Not Relevant actions.

A bolt action .303 rifle owned by Not Relevant

was stored in a shipping container on the property next to

Not Relevant

lives. Not Relevant has a key for the container and the .303 is currently missing and believed to be in the possession of Not Relevant. On 9/11/2009 & 14/11/2009 Not Relevant again had an altercation with family members, and was aggressive and violent towards them. He told family members that he has possession of the missing .303 rifle and that he would use it against people who owed him money.

Not Relevant further threatened his family members with an axe handle. Whilst at the address, the family members observed a number of knives laid out on various tables and bench tops on the property.

Not Relevant is known to local police as extremely violent and has mental issues due to long term drug use. Not Relevant has previously been assessed under Section 10 MHA.

Not Relevant was then tasered by Not Relevant. probe connection has not been successful due to the loose clothing he was wearing. Not Relevant has continued to resist and show aggression towards police. Not Relevant has then attempted to move towards other members and his vehicle. Not Relevant has subsequently tasered Not Relevant. This second taser deployment was also unsuccessful causing minimal and sporadic compliance. This was due to the probes not connecting effectively with Not Relevant skin. In an attempt to gain compliance from Not Relevant

have then used the taser in a drive stun capacity in an attempt to gain compliance from Not Relevant. Due to the initial probes failing to connect adequately, and having been dislodged further due to Not Relevant constant resisting and struggling with police, the drive stun initially had minimal affect. Not Relevant has then commenced to physically search under the engine of his vehicle with his left hand Not Relevant was then drive stunned again, before being physically moved from his vehicle and restrained.
