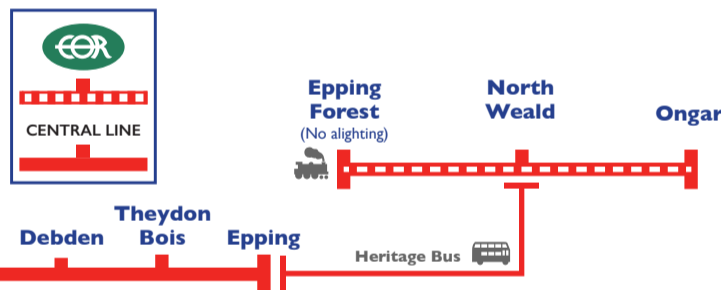

HOW TO FIND US



By Tube - The easiest way to visit us is via London Underground's Central Line to Epping Station where our frequent heritage buses pick you up from the front door.

By Train - We run heritage bus services direct from Shenfield Station to Ongar, North Weald and Epping.

By Car - Take junction 7 on the M11 towards Chelmsford and follow the brown signs from there to Ongar where there are car parks in the nearby town centre. Alternatively follow the signs to Epping, where you can pick up our heritage buses at the Tube Station or in the High Street.

Toilets - Toilet and baby changing facilities are at North Weald and Ongar Stations. There is a wheelchair accessible toilet at North Weald Station.

No Smoking - Smoking is prohibited on all Epping Ongar Railway Stations and vehicles.

Dogs - We welcome well controlled dogs, and they travel free. Dogs are not allowed in the shop, catering or picnic areas, except assistance dogs. Dog waste must be disposed of properly.

Disabled Visitors - We regret that our heritage buses are unable to accommodate wheelchairs. Limited disabled parking is available but we recommend that you book in advance. Please visit the website for our Railway Accessibility Statement.

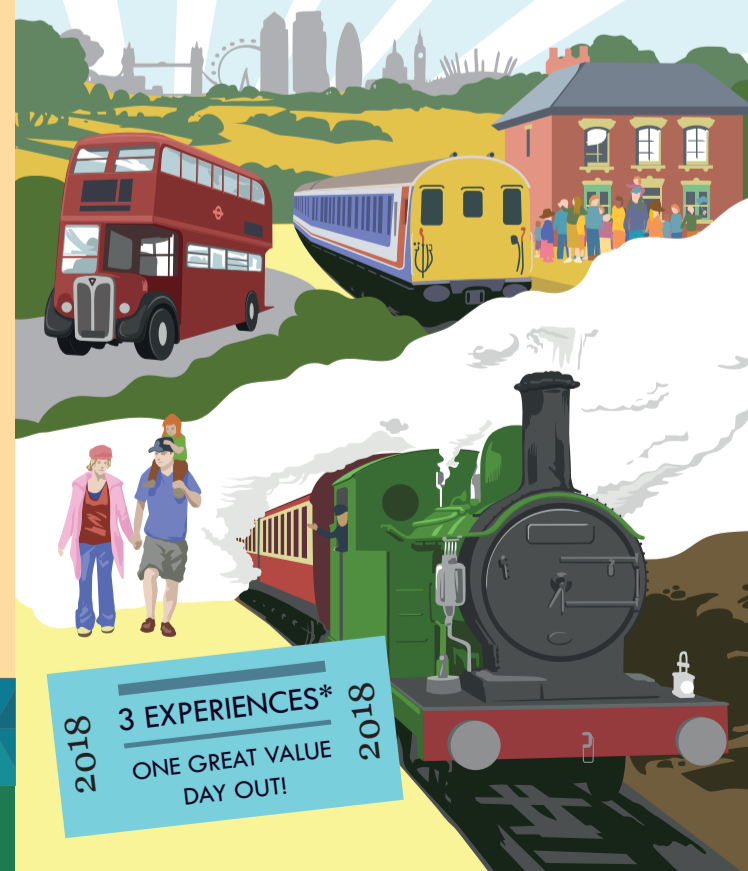

EPPING STATION

Epping Station is served by regular tube trains and is now the end of the Central Line. Our buses run from outside the station through Epping's bustling High Street, before heading through Epping Forest on their way to North Weald. The heritage bus journey is included within your ticket price. Tickets can be bought from the bus conductor.

NORTH WEALD STATION

North Weald Station is restored to its 1940's charm and offers beautiful countryside views - the perfect spot to sit and watch the trains go by! Regular heritage trains shuttle into the forest, whilst steam and diesel trains operate to Ongar. Don't forget to visit our gift shop or buffet coach for a great range of snacks and drinks while you're here.

ONGAR STATION

Ongar has always been the end of the line and boasts a grand 1865 Grade II listed Great Eastern Station. Following restoration by our volunteers back to its original format, it won the National Railway Heritage "Volunteers Award". The Station has a gift shop and a snack bar and there are picnic and viewing areas.

BLAKE HALL STATION

Approximately half way between Ongar and North Weald is the former Blake Hall Station, identical in size and style to North Weald. The Station was built for the grand manor house of the same name and for local farms. It was famed as being the least used Station on the London Underground network with just six passengers a day and was closed in 1981.
