

All notices should reach The Border Mail by 5pm the day prior to the notice appearing. If the notice includes a PHOTO and is published on Saturday the deadline is 12 noon Friday.

We require identification to place the notice in The Border Mail.

If the parents of the child are married, the identification of one parent or grandparent is required. If the parents are not married the identification of both parents are required.

Birth notices can be placed in person at The Border Mail, 1 McKoy Street, Wodonga or our Albury Office, cnr Kiewa and Dean Streets. If the parents are unable to personally place the notice the identification, e.g. Driver's Licence, can be photocopied and signed underneath.
