What's the problem?

- Many people use metered internet connections
- Cannot download everything they want to, when they want to
- Downloads have to be prioritised

What is metering?

- Pay per unit bandwidth used
- Pricing structures vary a lot
- Could have unmetered periods of the day
- **ℰ** Could be non-net-neutral

Does it affect me?

- Home/Work internet connection may be unlimited
- Trains, public Wi-Fi, mobile internet often aren't
- Main internet connection may be bandwidth constrained, even if unlimited
- Downloads can be prioritised

Introducing Mogwai

- Mogwai is a download scheduler
- It does downloads after midnight (hence the name)
 - lt's also a daemon, which ties in with the Cantonese meaning
- Applications ask it when to start 'big' downloads
- lt schedules all the requests and notifies the applications
- Uses various configuration, including tariff files


What Mogwai is not

- Not security it's an opt-in system
- Not currently monitoring bandwidth usage

How do I use it?

- libmogwai-schedule-client
- See source code for mogwai-schedule-client utility
- Or the 'Automatic Updates' panel in gnome-control-center

Future work — available for mentoring

- Monitor bandwidth usage to close the feedback loop
- Provide download statistics to GNOME Usage
- Account for more factors when scheduling downloads
