



2018 Pre-accredited Training @ CERES

The Victorian Government Adult and Community Further Education Board (ACFE) funds pre-accredited adult community education training places through Learn Local Organisations, such as CERES. The primary purpose of pre-accredited programs is to provide vocational training to engage the most educationally disadvantaged learners and initiate vocational and/or employment pathways for them.

Eligibility

ACFE subsidised training places are for those who:

- are Australian citizens, holder of an Australian permanent visa or New Zealand citizens
- over compulsory school-leaving age

There is a particular focus on:

- Women, including young mothers, women seeking to re-enter the workforce after significant time away, women who have experienced or are experiencing family violence
- People in low socio-economic localities
- Early school leavers (both mature and youth)
- Low-skilled and vulnerable workers
- Unemployed/underemployed people
- People from a culturally or linguistically diverse background
- People with a disability
- Young people who may be at risk of disengaging or who may have already disengaged from the community and/or education

Which courses are available?

CERES currently offers ACFE subsidised training places to eligible students undertaking the following courses:

- Complete Urban Farmer
- Sustainable Gardening
- Environmental Education
- Introduction to Horticultural Therapy
- Sustainable Events
- Introduction to Landscaping and Garden Maintenance

Fees
