The CERES DHHS Program works with young adults with a disability and is set in the CERES organic farm. The program employs a hands-on approach and provides a unique learning environment in which participants can meaningfully engage in sustainable practices, whilst developing strong interpersonal relationships with CERES trainers, other CERES staff, community and participants on the program.

Typically participants are engaged in practical activities such as animal care, planting, harvesting, packing market produce, garden maintenance, basic building and construction, as well as ongoing opportunities to work with other CERES teams.

This program provides an opportunity for those individuals who enjoy working independently.

### How to join the CERES DHHS Program:

Contact Luisa Cardamone, Training Area Manager, to book an appointment for an initial visit to see if the program is right for the individual. Family / carer and participant will be given an induction pack and Service Agreement for the program once a place is confirmed. CERES works with individuals, family, carers, case managers and planners to help you plan and become part of our program.

CERES provides access to our day service program to all cultures and has priority access to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders.
