More Trees for Mumbai on World Environment Day

On the occasion of World Environment Day, employees of BPCL MR's E&E department planted saplings at APMC market Vashi, Navi Mumbai as part of it's 'Green Earth' initiatives. BPCL Employees participated in large numbers and demonstrated their commitment towards Environment Conservation.

This venture is unique because of the involvement of APMC (Agricultural Produce Market Committee), who has been kind enough to grant permission to BPCL MR for planting tree saplings over four acres of land in the heart of the APMC market Vashi and taken the responsibility of maintaining/nurturing the plantation.

Fifty tree saplings of Black Ficus, Neem, Mahogany and Putranjeevi were planted on 5th June by APMC officials and BPCL MR Volunteers. This marks the beginning of BPCL MR's initiative of developing 'Green Belts' in and around Mumbai to restore the ecological balance.
