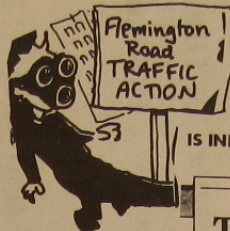

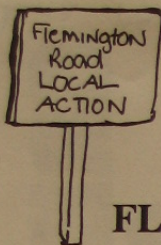

NORTH WEST FLEMINGTON ROAD TRANSPORT

The intersection of Flemington and Racecourse Roads is an urban disaster area. It has excessive levels of noise (currently 80 decibels, State Government limit 68 decibels), caused by the thousands of cars and trucks which pass through the area each day. Cars are the biggest polluters of the air and contribute a third of the gases leading to depletion of the Ozone Layer, according to the Government's own Greenhouse Report.

The removal of an existing railway line will increase this horror by cutting public transport, as well as destroying the possibility of rail freight, in order to create a freeway for road freight.

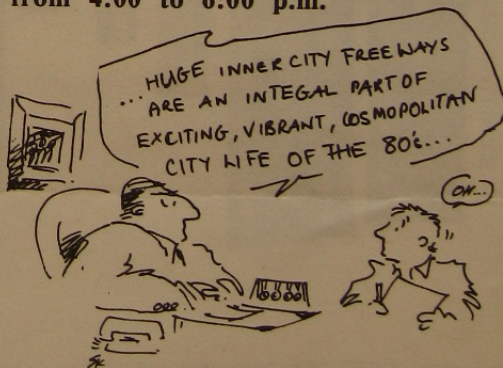
