The Fair Work Commission (FWC) has recently announced a 3.5% increase to minimum wages.

This increase applies from the first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2018.

The new national minimum wage for a full-time permanent employee will be \$719.20 per week. This equates to \$18.93 per hour and \$23.66 for a casual employee.

The increase only applies to employees that get their pay rates from:

- the national minimum wage
- a modern award, or
- some registered agreements.

If you are already paying more than the new minimum wages, then the increase won't affect your employees. But it is a good time to check that you are still paying more than the Award rates. If you're covered by a registered enterprise agreement, you should check it to see whether if there are increases contained in the agreement.
