

## **Does the Great Commission Apply to Me?**

Are pastors the only ones who are obligated to obey the Great Commission? If you observe the workings of a typical church today it does appear so. Of course, there may be sermons designed to produce guilt in anyone not doing it, but little attention is given to training the sheep how to reproduce.

Some designated "altar workers" receive inquirers who may be coaxed down the aisle during an "altar call." Formal training for these is rare, however. They are so designated because they stand out in the congregation as "mature Christians."

Many churches are more churchcentered rather than lost-centered. In conversations with some pastors it becomes apparent it is more important to get people to the church before, or instead of, getting

## Are We Reaping What We Have Sown?

Sometimes whole nations receive the just rewards for their sin. But often they don't realize it.

There is currently much handwringing in the US about the looming insolvency of the Social Security system, designed to care for the elderly. Many people have the misconception that it is an "investment," in which workers set aside money for their retirement.

In reality, it is a tax on young workers to pay for the monthly payments being made to retirees. It works great as long as you have lots more workers than retirees. But if you suddenly have

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them to Jesus. Members of that church are not focused on personally guiding someone to a commitment to Christ. Bring them to church and then the pastor can convert them.

Author David W. Daniels says that this may be partly caused by a change in the wording of the Great Commission in the modern Bibles. The preserved Bible, the King James, instructs us to go and "teach" or "preach" the gospel. But most of the modern versions say to "make disciples." We are "commissioned" to go and present the gospel whether someone surrenders to the process of discipleship or not. Disciples are mostly seen to be made primarily in the church. But we are "commissioned" to go out to next-door and to the ends of the earth and simply present the gospel.

This puts the responsibility upon all of us. We can pass off the "discipling" to the church, but we cannot escape our part. In order to teach or preach, we must learn. We must know why we are committed to the Kingdom of God and be able to communicate it. That is what "witness" means: to testify of what God has done for us and what He is ready to do for anyone else.

Our own story is a powerful way to start sharing the gospel. But that should only be the beginning. Proverbs tells us to get knowledge and wisdom, which is a lifetime endeavor. If we pursue it, we will be increasingly useful to the Kingdom in obeying the Great Commission.

But wherever we are in the process, there is work to do. No one can opt out. That is the beauty of gospel tracts. No matter where we are in our own discipleship, we can still "teach" and "preach" even though we may not be ready to "make disciples."

Soul-winners need a thorough understanding of this anti-God belief which has become the foundation of the secular, humanist belief system of most of the Western cultures.



## Why Would God Bother?

In 2012, Michael Gove, then England's Secretary of State for Education, announced a plan to send a King James Bible to every state school in England. The initiative met with mixed reactions. Some praised it, calling the King James Bible "a national treasure", "an important part of western cultural heritage", and "the single most influential literary work in the English language." Others were less than pleased. The National Secular Society claimed that schools were already "awash with Bibles" and that students would be better off with copies of Darwin's *On the Origin of Species*.

Andrew Zak Williams, writing for *The New Statesman*, questioned the value of the Bible. He concluded his article (titled, "the Trouble with the King James Bible") with the statement that the donated Bibles "should come with a slap in the face to those who think that it could possibly be the inspired and accurately-recorded Word of a loving God."

But what evidence did he cite for such a conclusion? We need look no further than two of the most popular arguments of modern liberal textual critics.

First, he attacked Mark 16:9-20 (the so-called "longer ending of Mark") as inauthentic. Then, citing agnostic New Testament scholar and textual critic Bart D. Ehrman, he went after 1st John 5:7-8, crucial verses supporting the biblical doctrine of the Godhead (the Father, Son and Holy Spirit as one).

These arguments have been ably answered in articles and books elsewhere (See <u>Answers to Your Bible Version</u> <u>Questions</u> by David W. Daniels, available from Chick Publications), but what is most striking about Williams' article is his question for believers, posed shortly after supposedly demolishing the text of the King James using the above arguments. Williams wrote, "Quite frankly, when you read the King James Bible, you have no way of knowing whether any particular line would have been in the original manuscripts. This poses an interesting question for those who believe that all scripture is Godbreathed: **if God was not going to preserve the original manuscripts, why would he have bothered to inspire them?**"

This question demonstrates an important reason why we ought to cling to our belief in God's preserved words. Williams' question is legitimate, and one that is dismissed far too easily by Christians with opposing views, but it does not come from a place of faith. He obviously does not believe Jesus' guarantee in Matthew 24:35 that "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."

The Bible itself is the foundation of our faith. When atheists or agnostics want to attack our faith in God, the legitimacy of the Bible as the very words of God is the first battle they choose.

As Psalm 11:3 says, "If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?"

# So Many Ways —So Little Time

There are different scenarios available to the soul-winner who seriously considers including Chick tracts in his witnessing.

The easiest is just to sneak one onto some place where it will be found later. Leaving one with the tip at a restaurant table or near the drink machine works this way. The message patiently waits for discovery. It takes about the same amount of time to fill a gas tank as it does to read a tract, if the driver discovers a tract rolled up under the trigger of the gas hose nozzle.

The next level is direct contact. Exchanging a tract for the receipt with a cashier at Starbucks or the Dollar Store requires a little more preparation. But we often patronize the same store over and over and always being ready with a different tract drives the good news deeper into the person's awareness.

Many Chick customers achieve the next level: buying case lots of tracts and handing them out in the middle of a river of pedestrians near a mall, school, or sporting event. One brave soul stood at a stop light and offered one to each waiting driver. It can't be any more dangerous than it is for the panhandlers who use this technique.

Besides having a tract ready, it helps to use some related comment. Favorites include:

"Have you seen one of these?" If no, then: "You may have it." If yes, then: "I have a different one. Would you like it?"

"Here is a great little story for your break time."

"Everyone who smiles at me today gets one of these." (This works best when their smile is in response to the one you gave them.)

One man I know who is six-foot four uses: "Everyone over (or under) six feet tall gets one of these, today."

"Everyone wearing a Dodgers cap gets one of these." Or any other identifiable item the person is wearing.

Sometimes the title of the tract provides a line:

"How's your trip going?" works for *The Long Trip* tract.



"Are you living the good life?" for <u>*This</u></u> <u><i>Was Your Life*</u>.</u>




The sky's the limit on this kind of creativity. It should let the person know that the tract is free and a gift to them.

Today, some have the opinion that this kind of "evangelism" is reserved for pastors or "evangelists." Of course, there are special gifts in these areas in the church. But nowhere does the Bible limit the Great Commission to those with special gifts. All believers are under Jesus" "commission."

Paul said that we are "ambassadors" for Christ. An ambassador is a citizen of one country, assigned to a foreign country to tell about his homeland. Our first citizenship is in the Kingdom of God. But we are "commissioned" to share the gospel (good news) here on earth until we are called home.

Every time we hand someone a tract we can declare: "(co)mission accomplished." And often, it only takes 10 seconds or less. Paul prayed for boldness. For him, it raised a threat to his life. Will we not be judged for how we use the safety and freedom we enjoy to also be bold with the news of eternal life?

marry two ladies, or two men, or a lesbian and a bisexual, and a straight person, or a gay, and a transgender or whatever suits their fancy. God was not too happy with their meeting that afternoon and just a few minutes after two p.m., God sent a wakeup call to a very liberal ELCA meeting.

On a day when no severe weather was predicted or expected, which baffled the weather experts, a tornado touched down just south of downtown Minneapolis, Minnesota and followed 35W straight towards the city center. It crossed I94 and hit the convention center where they were having this meeting, punching a hole in the Minneapolis Convention Center roof.

Across the street from the Convention center was a very liberal Evangelical Lutheran Church that people were using for their worship services that week. The tornado split the church's steeple, causing the cross on top of the steeple to tip completely over, dangling in midair.

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#### Philippines

Missionary Gerald Sutek describes his recent experience with the Chick tracts you provided: "On the last day of November (Friday night) we had 36 of our folk out for a hot, exciting, nighttime Christmas street meeting in one of the sections of our city. Our group passed nearly 2,500 tracts (all that we brought), held scripture signs and at least 8 preached to the countless multitudes shopping. We stood right at the exit doors and passed tracts without interruption as fast as we could open the Chick tract cellophane wrappers. All others pale in comparison. But unlike them, this one can be answered in moments by an open heart of childlike faith.




It's good when people are awake and asking questions. But God never told us to wait for that. He has told us to sow the seed wherever we can.
