

The staff members of the Green Party of the United States have decided to create a revolutionary, self-declared union, affiliated with the Industrial Workers of the World.

We've decided to unionize for two reasons.

First, to protect our rights as workers; to improve our bargaining position, and to act collectively in helping shape policy and direction of the Green Party of the United States.

Secondly, by joining a union, the staff, and by association, the Green Party of the United States, is placing itself firmly on the side of the working class and those most disadvantaged by the two-party duopoly of 21st century capitalism.

This politically motivated decision is an extension of the Green Party's long-standing pledge not to accept corporate funding. By joining the IWW, we've chosen to stand beside rank & file workers rather than accept the corrupt leadership of most of the labor movement that has more in common with the two-party duopoly than those they've been elected to represent.
