Dear Messrs. Calhoun and Estes:

I am writing in reference to your application for a Public Assembly Permit on February 2, 2019. In accordance with Stone Mountain Memorial Association Ordinance 5-102, Public Assembly Events, I am notifying you that your application to hold an event at Stone Mountain Park on Saturday, February 2, 2019, is denied.

Your application is being denied due to a previously scheduled event and a lack of public safety resources. Ordinance 5-102 E. 7 and 8, states that no public assembly event shall be conducted when it would materially disrupt Stone Mountain Park and presents a clear and present danger to the public health or safety.

Based on the previous violent event held by your organization on April 23, 2016, as well as your acknowledgement of potential violence in the permit application comments, the Stone Mountain Park Department of Public Safety does not have the available resources to protect not only the members of your organization but the Park employees and general public. Additionally, it was demonstrated by the previous event that a material disruption of Stone Mountain Park operations would exist as Stone Mountain Park had to close operations during your event to protect the public from violent confrontations.

TERMS and CONDITIONS

1. This permit must be carried by a participant present at the designated location at all times which the activity is permitted.
2. No participant may engage in disorderly conduct as defined in the Stone Mountain Memorial Association Code or state law.
3. No participant may obstruct or impede pedestrians or vehicles, harass Stone Mountain Park visitors with physical contact or persistent demands, or misrepresent the purposes of those engaged in the permitted activity.
4. No participant of the permitted activity may solicit or accept funds or offer any food or merchandise for sale.
5. No participant engaging in the activities of a Public Assembly event shall use any noise making device or sound or voice amplifying device.
6. Permittee agrees to make a reasonable effort to clean the area around the designated location of any litter created by the activity before exiting the area at the end of the designated time.
7. Violations of the terms and conditions of a permit issued in accordance with regulations may result in the suspension or revocation of the permit. Failure to enforce any terms and conditions on any occasion shall not constitute a waiver or modification of the permit terms.

We have published 3:00 pm as the time of the event on our public page. However for the safety of our participants and the other visitors to Stone Mountain Park, we wish to begin at 1:00 pm and end at 4:00 pm. We would like to keep this time concealed until the day of the event in order to avoid lawless attempts to block traffic by Antifa and other groups.

Also we respectfully request the lawn in front of the carving for our event. However we will respect wherever you decide to place us for security purposes. This information is also not on the permit for the same reason stated above. We seek to avoid violence and contact with the lawless mob for the sake of the women and children that will be in attendance. As you know from our past event, we are not the problem. This is after all a peaceful gathering of non-partisan citizens exercising our Constitutional rights. Thank you for your kind recognition of our freedom to assemble and our freedom of speech.
