## 'In Conversation with George Ciccariello-Maher' chaired by William Booth

Author of 'We Created Chavez: A People's History of the Venezuelan Revolution' (Duke University Press, 2013), 'Building the Commune: Radical Democracy in Venezuela' (Verso, 2016) and 'Decolonizing Dialectics' (Duke University Press, 2017), George Ciccariello-Maher is Assistant Professor in the Department of Politics at Drexel University.
