## **OSAMA BIN LADEN**

## THE MAN WHO KNEW TOO MUCH



Barack Obama, President of the United States, has announced that US military forces have killed Osama bin Laden and four others, including at least one member of his family. The world is no poorer for the loss of the architect of the atrocity of 11 September 2001 and,, by his own standards, bin Laden has nothing to complain about concerning his treatment.
