TRUMP GETS BUMP WITH APPROVAL ON ECONOMY, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY NATIONAL POLL FINDS; MOST EXPECT LITTLE FROM TRUMP, CONGRESS THIS YEAR

As more Americans feel good about the economy and President Donald Trump's handling of the economy, his overall job approval rating rises from a negative 33 - 61 percent August 2, his lowest grade since inauguration, to a negative 39 - 57 percent in a Quinnipiac University national poll released today.

A total of 62 percent of American voters describe the nation's economy as "excellent" or "good," the highest level since the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University Poll first asked this question in 2001. Another 36 percent say "not so good" or "poor."

A total of 74 percent of voters describe their personal financial situation as "excellent" or "good," while 24 percent say "not so good" or "poor."

President Barack Obama is more responsible than President Trump for the state of the economy, voters say 50 - 38 percent. For the first time, Republicans credit Trump for the state of the economy, 55 - 36 percent.

American voters are divided 46-46 percent on their approval of the way Trump is handling the economy, but this is an improvement on the negative 41-52 percent approval rating August 2.

"Sorely in need of an infusion of support, President Donald Trump can at least hang his hat on the economy, although it's a very small peg," said Tim Malloy, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

"He gets a shot in the arm from his own party on credit for economic conditions today, and a slight bump in overall approval.

"But that's about it.

"He remains deep in the weeds on character traits such as level headedness, empathy and honesty."

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President Trump is <u>not</u> levelheaded, voters say 67 - 30 percent, an improvement on August 2, when voters said 71 - 26 percent he was <u>not</u> levelheaded. Voter opinions of most other Trump qualities remain low:

- 59 37 percent that he is not honest;
- 59 39 percent that he does not have good leadership skills;
- 56 42 percent that he does not care about average Americans;
- 61 37 percent that he is a strong person;
- 58 40 percent that he is intelligent;
- 61 37 percent that he does <u>not</u> share their values.

American voters say 59 - 32 percent that Jared Kushner and Ivanka Trump should <u>not</u> continue to work in the White House. Republicans say 62 - 26 percent the First Family should remain, but every other group says no.

Trump gets negative approval ratings for handling some key issues:

- 39 58 percent for handling foreign policy;
- 47 percent approve of his handling of terrorism and 48 percent disapprove;
- 43 56 percent for immigration;
- 33 61 percent for the environment;
- 33 63 percent for health care.

Hope for Congress


American voters say 58 – 38 percent that President Trump and Republicans in Congress will <u>not</u> be able to pass any significant legislation in 2017. Republicans remain optimistic 65 – 30 percent, but every other group says no.

From August 9 - 15, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,361 voters nationwide with a margin of error of ± -3.4 percentage points, including the design effect. Live interviewers call landlines and cell phones.
