# **PARISH HISTORY**

Up to 1817 the Catholic congregation worshipped in their church in Dunleckney. In 1817 the Roman Catholic Church at Dunleckney was closed and St. Andrew's Church in Bagenalstown was opened for Christmas day 1820.

St. Mary's Church of Ireland and the Catholic Church co-existed on the same site at Dunleckney. The ruins of both churches still exist there to-day.

# **CHURCHES 'HISTORY**

#### **Roman Catholic:**

#### St. Andrew's, Bagenalstown

St. Andrew's opened for worship on Christmas Day 1820 and has continued in use to the present. The steeple was added in the mid 1800's. St. Andrew's was renovated in 1893 with porches added in 1917. The mortuary chapel was added in the 1950's.

#### St. Lazerian's, Ballinkillen

Built around 1793 it is one of the oldest churches in the diocese. It had a thatched roof in the early stages and to-day has beautiful stained glass windows. The Lourdes Grotto was officially opened in 1988 – this was completed by voluntary labour.

#### St. Patrick's, Newtown.

This church was burned down in 1798 and seems to have been rebuilt round 1833. The school was built in 1834..

A bell was erected in 1900; repair of the roof occurred round 1930. The Mosaics at the back of the altar and those round the exterior were added in the 1950's.

#### **Church of Ireland**

The Dunleckney Group of Parishes takes its name from the two ruined churches at Dunleckney near Bagenalstown. One of these was the Church of Ireland and was parish church of the area before the town of Bagenalstown began to grow in the 1790's upon the arrival of the Barrow Navigation, the canal. There are four churches within the group, as follows:

#### St. Mary's, Bagenalstown

This church was built in 1844, with the tower added in 1855. The church occupies a site in the town centre and is architecturally pleasing. It has next to it the former parochial school, now a parish hall. The hall is older than the church and is much admired for its classic proportions.

#### St. John's, Nurney

This is the oldest church in the group. The present building dates from 1792, but nearby Nurney High Cross (in a field behind the churchyard) is a strong clue to Nurney being an ancient Christian site with a history going back to the early Irish church. Nurney's spire has recently been repaired and conserved and is now safe and sound as a local landmark.

# The Good Shepherd, Lorum

This church occupies an ancient Christian site, with a High Cross shaft nearby. The tradition is that St. Lazarian paused at Lorum on his way from the Wexford coast, where he landed from Rome, to Old Leighlin where he founded his religious community. The present church dates from 1838 and replaces the older building in the graveyard behind it. The church has fine windows and a beautiful and unusually worked timber roof. The spire was added in the late nineteenth century.

## St. Peter's, Killedmond

This church was built in 1846 and occupies a place of great beauty between Borris and the western slope of Mount Leinster. It is a fine granite building of great strength and simplicity and is well placed for those travelling the various routes across the Blackstairs Mountains from the Barrow valley to County Wexford.

## All Saints', Fenagh.

This church opened in 1600's as there were burials in the surrounding grave yard dating from this time. It was burned down in 1798. Rebuilt in 1799 it continues to be used for worship up to the present time.
