Casual Street Trading Permit fees -

- 1. \$100 for permits issued ranging from one to ten days;
- 2. \$200 for permits issued from 11 days up to one month;
- 3. \$300 monthly permit fee for each cylinder trading more than one month

Please note that the permit fee is required to be paid in full prior to the permit and keys to the cylinder being issued. No full or partial refund of the permit fee will be made.
