GERRIT SMITH'S LETTER TO REV. LYMAN BEECHER, D. D.

Rev. Dr. Beecher, I am not writing this letter to you, Dr. Baxter, nor the author of the article on Slavery in the Liberator. I am writing to you, who had a justification for slavery in the Bible...

I fully believe in the truth of your declaration, that it is a lie to say that I put you in the case of the black man's friend...

This resolution (and no speaking, either of blacks or whites, ever passed one more honorable to human nature) was carried unanimously in a meeting of thousands of the colored people of Philadelphia...

You say in your preface: I know no reason, for my own sake, why I should not be as good as any other man with respect to Africa...

I am aware, that the Colonization Society desires that it is in its character or influence, an Anti-Slavery Society. I wish to see the Liberator...
