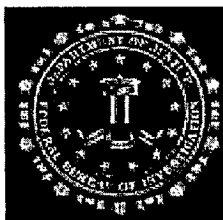
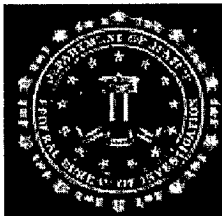

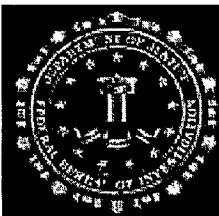

- Derivatives of the Dar Ul Islamic Movement, a domestic African-American Sunni Islamic fundamentalist movement.
  - Ummah Movement
- Espouses mixed Islamic theology with some levels of black separatism, anarchism, and racial rhetoric.
- Consider the U.S. to be anti-Islam/anti-minority rights.



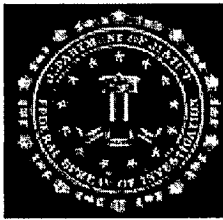
- Homegrown extremists who have motivation to commit criminal acts in furtherance of a radical Islamic agenda.

- These individuals do not take direction from or are affiliated with a foreign power or terrorist organization.

**American Islamic Extremist**

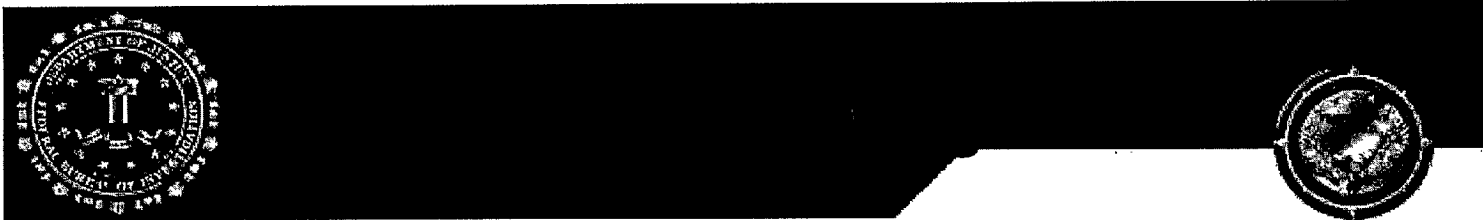

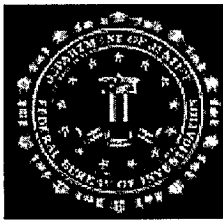
