A productive end-of-the-decade year sees 77 performances – including a celebrated autumn tour – multiple archival releases, the release of the long-awaited Martin Scorsese Rolling Thunder Revue film, the first World of Bob Dylan Symposium in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and more exhibitions of both artwork and also (at the Gilcrease Museum in Tulsa) artifacts.

3 THE 2019 CALENDAR

- 3 January Guitarist Steve Ripley, who played on *Shot of Love* and toured with Dylan in <u>1981</u>, dies in Pawnee, Oklahoma at the age of 69.
 7 January Frequent collaborator with Dylan from 1980-1984, singer Clydie King dies in California at the age of 75.
 23 January Signed, handwritten lyrics to "Like a Rolling Stone" (not the original manuscript) are auctioned online by <u>University Archives</u>.
 26 January Story appears about Dylan agreeing in 2018 to a co-writing credit with 19-year-old Trapper Schoepp on a song lyric that Dylan had written and abandoned on <u>November 20, 1961</u>: "On, Wisconsin." The song appears on Schoepp's album, *Primetime Illusion*.
 3 February Dylan licenses a version of "Blowin' in the Wind" sung by Cloves for a Super Bowl
- 3 February
 Dylan licenses a version of "Blowin' in the Wind" sung by Cloves for a Super Bowl

 Budweiser commercial promoting wind energy.
- 4 February Folklore Center owner (1957-1973) and promoter of Dylan's first major New York concert (Carnegie Chapter Hall), Izzy Young, dies in Stockholm at the age of 90.
- 8 February Pablo Dylan, Dylan's grandson, releases an EP, *The Finest Somersault*.
- 5 March Author and "official itinerant herbalist" of the Rolling Thunder Revue, <u>Susan Green</u>, dies at her home in Burlington, Vermont at the age of 76.
- 15 March Lyrical fragments emailed to Italian singer Jack Savoretti by Dylan become the basis for Savoretti's "<u>A Touchy Situation</u>" (co-credited to "Robert Zimmerman"), the eighth track on *Singing to Strangers*, released today.
- 31 March With the same five-piece band as the previous tour, Dylan kicks off a 24-night tour of Europe in <u>Dusseldorf, Germany</u>.
- 9 April To coincide with the 50th anniversary of the release of *Nashville Skyline*, Bob Dylan announces that in 2020 he will be opening his own whiskey distillery and music venue in Nashville: Heaven's Door Distillery and Center for the Arts. With a performance capacity of 360, the location will feature a restaurant and whiskey library, while also displaying Dylan's art and welded sculptures.
- 12 April Dylan sends a signed LP of *Time Out of Mind to* <u>Tower Records Dublin</u> in appreciation for its support over the years.
- 13 AprilColumbia/Legacy releases 7500 replica copies of the original 1974 test pressing of Bob
Dylan's *Blood on the Tracks* for Record Store Day.
- 16 April At a concert in <u>Vienna</u>, Dylan <u>addresses an audience member taking photographs</u> after tripping on an onstage monitor and almost falling down: "Take pictures or don't take pictures. We can either play or we can pose. Okay?"
- 19 April Dylan plays the 3000th show of the Never-Ending Tour in <u>Innsbruck, Austria</u>.
- 10 May <u>The Gilcrease Museum</u> in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in partnership with the Bob Dylan Center, launches *Bob Dylan: Face Value and Beyond*, exhibiting Dylan's *Face Value* series of pastel drawings along with other drawings, films, and artifacts from the Bob Dylan Archive, including a manuscript for "Chimes of Freedom" and one of the *Blood on the Tracks* manuscript notebooks. Although originally advertised as running until 2020, the exhibit runs until September 15, 2019.
- 24 May As Dylan turns 78, <u>Castle Fine Art</u> releases a new batch of reproductions of Dylan's paintings that are part of *The Beaten Path* series.
- 29 May Minnesota roots musician and music critic Tony Glover, harmonica player and vocalist for Koerner, Ray, & Glover, dies in St. Paul, Minnesota at the age of 79. Glover was an early peer and influence on Dylan while Dylan was in the St. Paul-Minneapolis area in the late 1950s and 1960; he was also a featured interview subject in *No Direction Home* and he

	wrote the liner notes for <i>Bootleg Series Vol. 4: Bob Dylan Live 1966, The "Royal Albert Hall" Concert.</i>
30 May	The World of Bob Dylan 2019 – an international conference covering Dylan's music, life, and work – cohosted by the University of Tulsa Institute for Bob Dylan Studies and the Bob Dylan Archive runs until June 2nd in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The symposium features 44 panels, 125 talks, a conversation with Roger McGuinn, and an exclusive glimpse into the Bob Dylan Archive hosted by curator Michael Chaiken.
	Leon Redbone, 69 years old, dies in Bucks County, Pennsylvania as he lived, a mystery. Dylan told <u>Ben Fong-Torres</u> of <i>Rolling Stone</i> in 1974: "Leon interests me [] I've heard he's anywhere from 25 to 60 [] I can't tell, But you gotta see him. He does old Jimmie Rodgers, then turns around and does a Robert Johnson."
6 June	Mac Rebennack, aka Dr. John, dies in New Orleans at the age of 77. In <i>Under a Hoodoo Moon: The Life of the Night Tripper</i> , Rebennack credited Dylan with giving him the inciting line ("I'm on the right trip, but I'm in the wrong car") for what became his 1973 hit "Right Place, Wrong Time."
7 June	Columbia/Legacy releases the 14-disc <i>Bob Dylan – The Rolling Thunder Revue: The 1975 Live Recordings</i> box set, featuring Dylan's complete sets from <u>Worcester, Cambridge</u> , the <u>afternoon</u> and <u>evening</u> shows from Boston, and <u>Montreal</u> , as well as rehearsals and rare performances from 1975.
11 June	Theaters across the country screen <i>Rolling Thunder Revue: A Bob Dylan Story by Martin Scorsese</i> , a 142-minute film constructed from 16mm footage of the 1975 leg of the Rolling Thunder Revue that is described by <i>Variety</i> as "part documentary, part concert film, part fever dream." The film features a 2017 or 2018 interview with Dylan conducted by Jeff Rosen. Internet rage is stoked by four fictional interviews featured in the film portrayed by Martin Von Hasselberg, Jim Gianopulos, Sharon Stone, and Michael Murphy.
12 June	Rolling Thunder Revue: A Bob Dylan Story by Martin Scorsese debuts on Netflix.
21 June	A short 14-night tour of <u>Europe begins</u> , culminating in two shows co-headlined with Neil Young in <u>London</u> and <u>Kilkenny, Ireland</u> .
	Elliot Roberts, who managed the careers of Neil Young, Joni Mitchell, Tom Petty, and others dies in Los Angeles at the age of 76. Roberts, who did some managing for Dylan in the 1980s, was responsible for suggesting that Tom Petty and The Heartbreakers back Dylan for the <u>True Confessions</u> and <u>Temples in Flames</u> tours, as well as for making the <u>initial overture to G.E. Smith in early 1988</u> that resulted in both G.E. Smith and Christopher Parker forming the nucleus of <u>Dylan's first self-created band</u> since 1984.
4 July	<i>Bob Dylan: A New Collection of Original Paintings</i> opens at the Halcyon Gallery in London.
11 July	Report that Bill Pagel, who already owns Dylan's childhood home in Duluth, purchased Dylan's childhood Hibbing home at 2425 7 th Ave. East. Pagel intends to restore the house to its appearance when Dylan lived there from 1948-1959 and convert both it and the Duluth home into a museum project.
14 July	The European leg of the tour comes to a close in Kilkenny where Dylan and Neil Young duet on "Will the Circle Be Unbroken?"
17 July	In an interview, Jack White mentions that he gets advice "all the time" from Dylan: "All the time. He's been an incredible mentor to me, and a good friend, too. I'm lucky to even have one conversation with him. Everything else has been icing on the cake."
28 July	Joan Baez concludes her final tour with a performance at Teatro Real in Madrid.
1 August	Filmmaker D. A. Pennebaker, pioneer of cinema vérité and director of <i>Don't Look Back</i> (1967) dies in Sag Harbor, New York at the age of 94. Pennebaker also operated a camera during the filming of Dylan's 1966 tour of Europe and assembled the unreleased <i>Something is Happening</i> from that footage, some of which was used by Dylan in <i>Eat the Document</i> (1972). Pennebaker assembled unused 1965 footage shot for <i>Don't Look Back</i> into the one-hour documentary <i>65 Revisited</i> for the 2007 DVD release of <i>Don't Look Back</i> . Footage for

	all of these projects was used in Scorsese's <i>No Direction Home</i> (2005), as was an interview with Pennebaker conducted by Jeff Rosen (cleverly shot with a handheld camera).
5 August	American Nobel Prize laureate Toni Morrison dies in New York City at the age of 88. She released a statement at the time of Dylan winning the Nobel Prize calling the selection of Dylan by the Nobel Academy an "impressive choice."
20 August	Louie Kemp's memoir, <i>Dylan and Me</i> , is published, recounting Kemp's friendship with Dylan, spanning 1953 to 2001.
29 August	195 silkscreen prints of "Train Tracks" from <i>Drawn Blank Series</i> go on sale for £14,950 at <u>Castle Fine Art locations, first in Edinburgh</u> , then <u>York</u> , then elsewhere, and always on castlefineart.com.
1 September	Former Dylan bassist Rob Stoner (1975-1978) <u>tweets</u> that he heard from current bassist Tony Garnier (since 1989) that Dylan is "cutting back on the relentless gigging," although Dylan's 77 shows in 2019 are only a few less than in recent years and one must go back to 2010 to find a year that had 25 more shows than 2019's number of gigs.
13 September	Dylan's 1969 duet with Johnny Cash from <i>Nashville Skyline</i> , <u>"Girl From the North</u> <u>Country,"</u> is included on the 2-disc soundtrack to <i>Country Music – A Film by Ken Burns</i> .
15 September	Dylan's influential decision to record in Nashville from 1966-1969 and his friendship and recordings with Johnny Cash are featured subjects in Ken Burns's 8-episode documentary, <i>Country Music</i> , debuting on PBS in the United States from September 15-25.
16 September	Musician and musicologist, John Cohen, a founding member of the New Lost City Ramblers, passes away at the age of 87. Cohen was a featured interview subject in <i>No</i> <i>Direction Home</i> (2005). His 8mm footage of Dylan on a New York City rooftop in the spring of 1962 is the first film of Dylan in New York and is featured in the 2005 documentary.
23 September	Robert Hunter dies in San Rafael, California at the age of 78. Hunter collaborated with Dylan on the lyrics to "Silvio" and "Ugliest Girl in the World" from <i>Down in the Groove</i> , nine of the ten songs from <i>Together Through Life</i> , and "Duquesne Whistle" from <i>Tempest</i> .
1 October	Invaluable online resource, <u>expectingrain.com</u> , celebrates its 25 th anniversary. Thank you Karl Erik Andersen!
5 October	Musician and Bob Dylan author, Peter Stone Brown, passes away at the age of 68. He wrote the liner notes to <i>Bootleg Series Vol. 8: Tell Tale Signs: Rare and Unreleased 1989-2006.</i>
28 September	The exhibition <i>Retrospectum</i> opens in the Moden Art Museum in Shanghai, China. It spans five decades of Dylan's artistic career, featuring more than 250 painting and drawings created using different mediums including oil, acrylic and watercolor paint, ink, pastel and charcoal as well as ironwork sculptures.
11 October	Dylan begins a 39-night tour of the West Coast, Midwest, and East Coast of the United States in Irvine, California, primarily playing college campuses and garnering exceptional reviews. In Irvine, Dylan introduces the 25 th Never-Ending Tour band, marking his first introduction of his band to the audience in over four years, the last time being at his concert in <u>San Daniele del Friuli, Italy</u> on 27 June 2015. Drummer George Recile, who played with Dylan from 2002-2019, is replaced with Matt Chamberlain. Bob Britt, who performed on <u>Time Out of Mind</u> , is added on guitar, returning the band to a six-person outfit.
12 October	Swedish literary critic, professor, and also member (and first female secretary, 2015-2018) of the Swedish Academy (2013-2018), Sara Danius, passes away in Stockholm at the age of 57. Danius was secretary of the Academy when Dylan was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature in 2016.
15 October	A line of clothing from New York designer label Barking Irons – the Rolling Thunder Apparel Collection – becomes available through <u>barkingirons.com</u> .
1 November	<i>Bootleg Series Vol. 15: Travelin' Thru, 1967-1969,</i> a 3-disc compilation of alternate studio versions and outtakes recorded for <i>John Wesley Harding, Nashville Skyline,</i> and <i>Self Portrait</i> is released. The collection leans into Dylan's collaborations with Johnny Cash, both in the studio and the Johnny Cash TV show, and also includes Dylan's 1970 recordings

	with Earl Scruggs for the documentary <i>Earl Scruggs Performing with His Family and Friends</i> , perhaps to capitalize upon the release of both Ken Burns's recent <i>Country Music</i> documentary as well as Thom Zimny's new documentary, <i>The Gift: The Journey of Johnny Cash</i> , which debuted November 11 th .
8 November	Dylan's version of <u>"Like a Rolling Stone"</u> with the Rolling Stones from April 1998 is included in both the CD and Blu-ray/DVD version of The Rolling Stones's <i>Bridges to Buenos Aires</i> .
23 November	Dylan begins a triumphant 10-night residency at the Beacon Theatre in New York City. Many celebrities are spotted at the shows, especially toward the end of the run.
26 November	Site of the new Bob Dylan Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma is <u>announced</u> as the Philbrook Museum of Art at 116 Reconciliation Way in the Tulsa Arts District.
3 December	After the band introductions at the Beacon Theatre, Dylan introduces Jack White, who is in the audience, as "a great performer, great record-maker, great songwriter," even asking that the spotlight be put on White.
5 December	After the band introductions at the Beacon Theatre, Dylan introduces Steve Earle and Jann Wenner, who are in the audience. He identifies Wenner as from <i>Rolling Stone</i> , "the magazine of sex, drugs, and politics."
6 December	After the band introductions at the Beacon Theatre, Dylan introduces Steven Van Zandt and Martin Scorsese, both of whom are in the audience. Dylan jokes that <i>The Last Temptation of</i> <i>Christ</i> is his favorite Scorsese film and that Scorsese should make " <i>The First Temptation of</i> <i>Christ</i> ." Sitting at the table with Scorsese is Leonardo DiCaprio. Also spotted at the show are guitarist Lenny Kaye and author Larry "Ratso" Sloman.
	The 2-disc 50 th Anniversary Collection 1969 is made available as an extremely limited release. It includes Dylan's <u>studio recordings from 1969</u> that remained unreleased after <i>Bootleg Series Vol. 15: Travelin' Thru, 1967-1969</i> .
	The 8-song soundtrack to the podcast <i>Bear and a Banjo</i> , co-produced by Dennis Quaid and T-Bone Burnett, is <u>released</u> , featuring Poo Bear's (Jason Boyd's) <u>"Gone But Not Forgotten,"</u> with <i>Basement Tapes</i> -era lyrics by Dylan.
8 December	Dylan concludes his touring for the year with a show in Washington, D.C.
26 December	American actress Sue Lyon, star of <i>Lolita</i> (1962), <u>who was represented in Dylan's</u> <u>"Midnight Caller" painting from <i>The Beaten Path</i>, dies in Los Angeles at the age of 73.</u>




Andrew Muir: The True Performing of It: Bob Dylan & William Shakespeare. <u>Red Planet</u> 2019. Softback, 368 pages.

The True Performing Of It places the two writers side by side and examines the resultant analogies in their work that spring from this positioning. After a teasing prologue, the book begins by reflecting on the significance of Dylan's remarks on Shakespeare when accepting the Nobel Prize for Literature, before examining their shared bardic qualities, and their position of being feted for their undoubted literary qualities despite both being primarily artists of live performances of drama and music. The movement from 'low' to 'high' art is traced and its implications explored in depth and detail, as is the fierce opposition that the parallel theatrical and musical transitions from communal folk art to professional entertainment engendered. The parallels in their approaches to performing art, use of language, and source material form core chapters of the book. The last section of the book is an in-depth focus on *The Tempest* and *Tempest* as specific examples of the theories and generalities explored in previous chapters.


Keith Nainby and John M. Radosta: Bob Dylan In Performance: Song, Stage and Screen. Lexington Books 2019. Hardback, 297 pages.

This study of Bob Dylan's art employs a performance studies lens, exploring the distinctive ways he brings words and music to life on recordings, onstage, and onscreen. Chapters focus on the relationship of Dylan's recorded performances to the historical bardic role, to the American popular song tradition, and to rock music culture. His uses of both stage and studio to shape his performances are explored, as are his forays into cinema. Special consideration is given to his vocal performances and to his use of particular personae as a performer. The full scope of Dylan's body of work to date is situated in terms of the influences that have shaped his performances and the ways these performances have shaped contemporary popular music.


The love songs of Bob Dylan provide a unique template on which to map the changes in American society since the 1960s. In looking across a diverse range of Dylan's songs, the book will explore issues surrounding masculinity, femininity, sexuality, and identity from such a perspective. There have been many books on Dylan, but this present work might be seen as distinct from others insomuch as it will employ the use of specific aspects of cultural theory to explore the underlying appeal of Dylan's prolific output. In this way, it might be said to be a unique example within the world of Dylan studies, as the book possesses relatively little interest in Dylan the man, but a great sense of interest in the songs he has written, in the cultural texts he has produced. As such, the book aspires to offer an accurate depiction of Bob Dylan's reputation as an American songwriter.

Mike Wyvill & John Wraith: Over the Road: Dylan's 2018 Concerts. <u>Two Riders</u> 2019. Softback, 64 pages.

One in an ongoing series of Bob Dylan tour summaries. This volume features complete track listings of every 2018 show and is lavishly illustrated with photos, tickets, and other ephemera.
