Regardless of your desired look, Rickman offers one piece of important finishing advice. "Look for an oil-based stain, or paint and primer system," he says.

"Water-based products sit on the surface and are prone to cracking and peeling. Oilbased products soak into the wood, providing superior protection and performance, especially in wet zones like bathrooms."
