

"We are facing a critical phase, due to peace conference in which some opposition factions participated and we all the time repeated, warning against attempts of hijack the Syrian Revolution since the beginning.

The most dangerous of those is the so called Astana, that we rejected by all means while a lot of people blamed us for that but many are supported what we said and done about it during Astana talks.

The so called Astana talks succeeded in conferring legitimacy to the Russia occupation and it's place as part of a political solution and even a "peace guarantor" for stopping ASSad Criminal Regime atrocities and Russia along with Iran succeeded in

forcing many opposition factions to don't fight against ASSad Regime in the fronts, even making some of the brothers in the opposition start media campaigns against Tahrir alSham always when starting offensives, offensives against the ASSad Regime "became a criminal act" for them.

There was cases of even the opposition sent our Intel, details in general of our battles to the enemies. All of this happened while the ASSad Regime continued with it's non stop military operations. Then, the deescalation zones were formed via an agreement to divide the North side into Turkey and Russia atmosphere influences, the so called "agreement" included a complete surrender of the areas in the East side of the railway, which became outside the descalation zones, which we saw in the leaked agreement maps.

Astana talks agreement just gave the ASSad Regime and it's allies the right attack and recaptured the areas. We rejected it all, we rejected the agreement and we communicated our position to Turkey as well to the opposition groups, some in the

opposition tried to make the Mujahedeen withdraw from those areas in peace.

We rejected the deal, which unfortunately armed groups agreed to, all of this cost us several Mujahedeen and more than 200,000 families were forcibly displaced as a result of it, they that paid the price for the reckless of those who agreed with Astana talks.

Astana also included Turkish checkpoints to be setup across the region, we rejected it because it had no future guarantors those areas would be given to ASSad Regime easily via deals. We also rejected it because it would make the jihad and fighting spirit weak even perhaps making more difficult to defend the fronts.

We looked out to minimize the costs and prevent a war that would damage all of us, we reached a compromise with Turkey, which infuriated ASSad Regime and it's allies, who was counting on we start a war against Turkey in Idlib, the enemies saw that this plan didn't work so after that, they came with a worst plan, which in October they used Da3sh khawareej members and weapons in Eastern Hama countryside, the move by Da3sh cost us several Mujahedeen and material losses.

It was the main reasons ASSad Regime could advance quickly in those areas, while some opposition factions turned a blind eye to the situation. ASSad Regime continued it's military campaign there, now the battles is lasting more than 100 days, we are relaying details to clarify the situation to our people in Syria.

The last days, opposition factions joined the offensive against ASSad Regime, which we welcomed and appreciated, considering to be better than liberating new areas, even if ASSad Regime manage to occupy these areas, we are sure the will of the Mujahedeen to fight are revived."
