5 repealing Articles 1191, 1192, 1193, 1194, and 1196, Penal Code
6 of Texas, 1925, which relate to the offense of abortion; and
7 declaring an emergency.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

9 Section 1. Articles 1191, 1192, 1193, 1194, and 1196,
10 Penal Code of Texas, 1925, are repealed.

11 Section 2. The importance of this legislation and the
12 crowded condition of the calendars in both Houses create an
13 emergency and an imperative public necessity that the Consti-
14 tutional Rule requiring bills to be read on three several days
15 in each House be suspended, and this Rule is hereby suspended,
16 and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after
17 its passage, and it is so enacted.
