Celtics Head Coach Ime Udoka was named the NBA's Eastern Conference Coach of the Month for the months of March and April 2022 after the team finished 15-4 during the final two months...Udoka is the first coach to receive the award in consecutive months since Doc Rivers in 2008.

TATUM AND BROWN EQUAL MARK SET 35 YEARS AGO BY BIRD AND AINGE ...

Jayson Tatum recorded 31 points to go along with six assists while Jaylen Brown added 32 points and seven assists in the 128-123 victory over the Pacers on Apr. 1...It was the first time since Game 2 of the 1987 Eastern Conference Semifinals that two Celtics had recorded 30 points and five assists in the same game joining Larry Bird and Danny Ainge according to ESPN Stats & Info.

TATUM FOURTH PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR IN 21-22 SEASON ...

Ime Udoka begins his first season as the Head Coach of the Boston Celtics. He was hired to the position on June 28, 2021 and officially became the organization's 18th Head Coach.

Udoka joined the Celtics from the Brooklyn Nets where he was an assistant coach during the 2020-21 season. Prior to his time in Brooklyn he spent one season serving as an assistant coach with the Philadelphia 76ers (2019-20) and seven seasons in San Antonio (2012-19) where he was on the coaching staff under Gregg Popovich that won the 2014 NBA Championship. Udoka has been a part of coaching staffs that have made playoff appearances in each of the last nine seasons that he has been on the sideline.

Prior to beginning his coaching career, the Portland, OR native played professionally for 12 years (2000-12) in the NBA, NBA G-League, International Basketball Association and the United States Basketball League as well as with teams in France and Spain. He appeared in 316 NBA games across parts of seven seasons with the L.A. Lakers (2004), New York (2006), Portland (2006-07), San Antonio (2007-09 and 2010-11) and Sacramento (2009-10), recording averages of 5.2 points, 2.9 rebounds and 1.0 assists in 18.1 minutes per game. Udoka was named the NBA G League's Jason Collier Sportsmanship Award winner in 2006, while also earning All-NBA G League First Team honors in the same season. He also represented Nigeria in international competition, earning bronze medals in 2005 and 2011 at the African Championships. Udoka began his collegiate career at Utah State University Eastern (1995-97) and spent a year (1997-98) at the University of San Francisco before finishing at Portland State (1999-00).
