PROCUREMENT

- Suppliers will have to commit to reducing their emissions to remain on our roster.
- Suppliers will be reviewed on an environmental basis annually.

ENERGY

- We aim to reduce all non-renewable electricity and gas within offices by 5% a year until emissions are halved. To aid this offices globally will request building management to swap to renewable energy providers by 2030
- Terrapinn have implemented a hybrid working policy to save on office energy.





STAFF TRAVEL

- Terrapinn commit to offset all staff travel by 2030
- New travel policies will be put in place to lower our CO2e footprint globally.

INTERNAL FOOD & BEVERAGE / FUNCTIONS

 Terrapinn will increase it's plant-based options for all internal and external meetings and functions starting immediately.





WASTE

• Terrapinn will aim to divert as much waste as possible from landfill and will ensure waste is segregated and recycled within all buildings globally.

EVENT LEVEL

EMISSION COMMITMENTS

- Terrapinn commit to measure the emissions of every event from all services we contract from 2023.
- On all events, we aim to reduce emissions by 50% from it's baseline year and offset the remaining CO2e by 2027. Therefore, making our events Carbon Neutral.
- On all events, aim to reduce emissions by 90% from it's baseline year and offset the remaining CO2e by 2050. Therefore, making our events Net Zero.



TERRAPINN

SUSTAINABILITY POLICY

EVENT LEVEL

ENERGY



- Terrapinn will deprioritise venues if they do not show evidence of energy reductions or switching to renewable energy sources by 2030.
- We will aim to reduce emissions associated with electricity, gas and fuel usage from the services we contract. Suppliers will have to provide this information as part of the procurement process year on year to remain a client to Terrapinn.

TRAVEL & TRANSPORT

- Terrapinn will ensure all event associated Travel and Transport emissions resulting from staff travel, audience travel and from services we have contracted are reduced as far as possible.
- All staff accommodation will be booked in Green Globe certified hotels or hotels within renewable energy by 2025 (country permitting).



CATERING



- Terrapinn commit to design menus which are 50% plant-based from 2023.
- Any meat and dairy products seen in the menu will have been sourced locally where geographically possible.
- Single use plastic water bottles will not be available inside our events by 2025.

PRODUCTION

- Show features, signage and stages will be designed with the Circular Economy in mind to reduce waste generation and therefore divert waste from going to landfill.
- We will prioritise the use of materials that can either be reused or recycled.
- We commit to make sure stage designs are 80% recyclable by 2025.
- Plastic badge holders will be removed from all events globally by end-of-year 2023.
- Aisle carpets will be removed from events by 2025 (venue permitting). Where this is not possible, suppliers will be requested to source reusable options or more ecofriendly/recycled options.
- All offices globally will have a totally reusable/recyclable stand option to offer clients in the cities we run events by 2023.
- All organiser small printed items shall be banned from our events by 2024.
