BUCK SHOTS

- The Milwaukee Bucks wrap up their two-game road trip on Saturday against the Orlando Magic. After Saturday's game, the Bucks will return home for one game to face the Bulls on Monday before heading back out on the road for a two-game road trip that starts on Tuesday in Toronto.
- The Bucks have won their last 14 games against the Magic, which is tied for their longest active win streak against an opponent (along with their streak against the Kings) and is currently the longest active win streak by any team in the NBA against an opponent (along with their streak against the Kings). Overall, this is tied for the 3rd-longest opponent win streak in franchise history and is one win away from being tied for the second-longest.
- In Thursday's game against the Pacers, Giannis Antetokounmpo poured in 54 points (19-25 FG, 16-18 FT), which was one shy of matching his career-high and three away from matching the franchise record of 57. Antetokounmpo's 54 points ended up being tied for the fourth-most in a game in franchise history and were the most in franchise history in a road game. This was Antetokounmpo's 7th regular season game with 50+ points, which trails only Kareem Abdul-Jabbar (10) for the most 50-point games in franchise history. Antetokounmpo is now up to 8th in the NBA in scoring this season, averaging 28.1 ppg.
- After tallying only two blocks in the first four games of the season combined, Brook Lopez has now swatted away 3+ blocks in three of his last four games. Lopez had three blocks against the Pacers on Tuesday, pushing his season total to 17. His 2.13 blocks per game this season currently ranks tied for 6th in the league.

MILWAUKEE BUCKS LAST THREE GAME RECAPS

Bucks at Pacers – Thursday, Nov. 9 – Gainbridge Fieldhouse – Indianapolis, Indiana

L, 124-126 – Giannis Antetokounmpo scored a season-high 54 points as the Bucks and Pacers battled it out at Gainbridge Fieldhouse on Thursday, with the Bucks falling 124-126. Milwaukee fell behind by 18 points early in the first quarter as the Pacers opened the game shooting 50% from three. The Bucks refused to give up early and came roaring back in the second quarter, shooting 63.6% from the field and outscoring Indiana 36-28 to go into halftime with a 60-66 deficit. Antetokounmpo opened the third quarter with nine straight points that brought the Bucks within two points. Khris Middleton was fouled soon after and made both shots, tying the game at 71 points apiece with 9:32 remaining in the third. The teams fought a close quarter for the rest of the frame, with 11 lead changes and six ties that saw the Bucks come out on top with a 94-93 lead. Milwaukee kept up the momentum and opened the fourth quarter on a 19-10 run, with a Malik Beasley three giving the Bucks a 113-110 lead. The Pacers began mounting a comeback of their own and forced a tie at 119 with 2:30 left. Cameron Payne made a layup, but Indiana hit a three to take a 122-121 lead. The Bucks attempted to retake the lead but time expired before they could finish the job. Antetokounmpo also hauled in 12 rebounds to lead the Bucks while Payne dished out a team-high five assists. The Pacers were led by Tyrese Haliburton with 29 points.

Bucks vs. Pistons – Wednesday, Nov. 8 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, Wisconsin

W, 120-118 – Damian Lillard scored 18 fourth quarter points to help the Bucks close out a tight final frame in their 120-118 victory over the Pistons on Wednesday at Fiserv Forum. The Bucks led for much of the second and third quarters until the Pistons started to shift the momentum late in the third. Detroit took an 87-88 lead with 2:13 remaining in the third quarter and began pulling away. Detroit tried to finish the comeback, leading 101-111 with 6:22 left in the fourth, but Lillard scored four straight points to cut it to a five-point game. The Pistons scored again, but Malik Beasley answered with a floating shot. The Bucks trailed 108-113 with 5:06 remaining until Lillard went on his own 8-2 run that put Milwaukee back on top 116-115. Brook Lopez drained a three on the next possession to give the Bucks a 119-115 lead, but Cade Cunningham made a three that cut it to a 119-118 game. The Pistons tried to retake the lead, but Beasley stole the ball and passed to Jae Crowder, who was fouled and sank a free throw to give the Bucks a two-point victory. Lillard totaled a game-high 34 points, while Bobby Portis Jr. chipped in 18 points of his own. Giannis Antetokounmpo led the Bucks with nine rebounds and five assists, and Lopez had four blocks. Cunningham led the Pistons with 33 points.

Bucks at Nets – Monday, Nov. 6 – Barclays Center – Brooklyn, New York

W, 129-125 – Giannis Antetokounmpo scored a season-high 36 points and the Bucks put up 66 second-half points to get past the Nets at Barclays Center on Monday, 129-125. A close game that saw six lead changes and 11 times, was close through three quarters of play with the Bucks holding a slim 96-94 advantage. Milwaukee started the fourth quarter on a 7-0 run to open up a nine-point lead, but Brooklyn responded with a 12-2 run of its own to regain the lead with 6:13 remaining. From there, neither team led by more than three until the final 12 seconds of the game when Damian Lillard free throws put the Bucks up five after an Antetokounmpo lay-in put them up two with 1:11 left. Trailing by five, the Nets cut it to three with 8.4 seconds remaining before one final Jae Crowder free throw sealed the win for Milwaukee. Antetokounmpo also hauled in a season-high-tying 12 rebounds while Lillard finished with 21 points and a game-high 7 assists. Crowder came off the bench and scored a season-high 15 points for the Bucks, whose 129 points marked a season-high. The Nets were led by Cam Thomas who scored 45 points.

W, 134-123 – Playing without Giannis Antetokounmpo and Jrue Holiday, the Bucks shot a season-best 59% from the field to defeat the Magic 134-123 at Amway Center on Tuesday. The Bucks opened the game on an 11-4 run before the Magic lit up and took a 15-16 lead. Brook Lopez made a free throw to tie it back at 16 points and made his second one to send the Bucks back up 17-16. Orlando made a quick floated but a layup from Lopez gave Milwaukee a 19-18 lead, its final lead of the contest. The Bucks kept pulling ahead into the second quarter and finished the half with a 70-60 lead. Despite attempts from Orlando to climb back into the game, the Bucks never led by fewer than eight points in the second half and took a 16-point lead, their largest of the game, on a Grayson Allen layup with 5:15 remaining in the fourth quarter. Jevon Carter was a perfect four-for-four in the fourth quarter, helping the Bucks shoot 65% overall in the frame and close the game out. Lopez led the Bucks with 26 points, while Bobby Portis Jr. hauled in 11 rebounds and scored 16 points. Khris Middleton dished out a team-leading 11 assists and scored 24 points of his own and Carter also chipped in 24 points. The Magic were led by Cole Anthony with 23 points.

W, 140-128 – The Bucks clinched the number one seed in the Eastern Conference with a 105-92 win over the Bulls at Fiserv Forum on Wednesday. After two close quarters of play, Chicago led 51-49 heading into the half. The Bulls opened the third quarter on a 10-2 run, but Bobby Portis Jr. made a driving layup that tipped off a 15-0 run for the Bucks that helped them regain a 66-61 lead. Chicago pulled back to tie it at 72 before Brook Lopez hit a cutting layup to put the Bucks back up 74-72. This was the final lead change of the game as the Bucks surged ahead into the fourth quarter. Portis Jr. sank a three with 6:33 remaining in the fourth that sent the Bucks up 94-8 and started an 11-4 run that led to a 16-point lead, the largest of the game for the Bucks. Portis Jr. tallied his 38th double-double of the season, leading Milwaukee with 27 points and 13 rebounds. Jrue Holiday dished out a season-high 15 assists and scored 20 points of his own, while Lopez also chipped in 26 points for his third straight game with 20+ points. The Bulls were led by Nikola Vucevic with 21 points.

Right before training camp, Horst made a splash by acquiring 7x All-NBA honoree and 7x All-Star Damian Lillard and in the days leading up to the start of the regular season, signed 2x MVP Giannis Antetokounmpo to a multi-year extension.

HEAD COACH ADRIAN GRIFFIN



A new era of Bucks basketball begins as first-year head coach Adrian Griffin takes over as the 17th head coach in franchise history. Griffin, who was hired as head coach in June, brings 24 seasons of NBA playing and coaching experience to the Bucks, most recently spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach with the Toronto Raptors. With Toronto, Griffin was part of the coaching staff that won the 2019 NBA Championship and made the playoffs three times while posting a 227-163 (.582) regular season record.

In Griffin's time as an assistant coach with the Raptors, Toronto finished in the league's top 10 of both defensive rating and fewest points allowed per game in four of his five seasons, including in 2019-20 when the Raptors allowed a league-low 106.5 points per game. He was part of the development of a young core of players that included the league's Most Improved Player, the NBA Rookie of the Year and four players who made six All-Star appearances.

Prior to joining the Raptors, Griffin spent two seasons as an assistant coach with the Oklahoma City Thunder from 2016-18. His NBA coaching experience also includes stops as an assistant coach with the Orlando Magic (2015-16), Chicago Bulls (2010-15) and the Bucks (2008-10). In Griffin's 15 seasons as an assistant coach, he was part of teams that made the playoffs 11 times, with two Conference Finals appearances in addition to winning an NBA title with the Raptors in 2019.


A native of Wichita, Kansas, Griffin began his coaching career after a nine-year NBA playing career with Boston, Dallas, Houston, Chicago and Seattle from 1999-08. He appeared in 477 regular-season games in his NBA career and averaged 4.0 points in 16.8 minutes per game. Griffin also saw action in 48 playoff games, including in 2006 when he reached the NBA Finals with the Mavericks.

Griffin played collegiately at Seton Hall for four seasons where he earned All-Big East Second Team honors as a senior and was inducted into the school's Athletics Hall of Fame in 2010. After his collegiate career, Griffin played professionally in the United States Basketball League, the Continental Basketball Association and internationally in Italy. His coaching experience also includes working with the USA men's national team that won gold at the FIBA Basketball World Cup in Spain in 2014.
