

# **Overseas travel and tourism March 2007**

In the three months to March 2007, compared with the previous three months, the seasonally adjusted results from the International Passenger Survey showed that:

- Overseas residents' visits to the UK increased in number by 2 per cent to 8.5 million
- Overseas earnings decreased by 2 per cent at £3.7 billion
- UK residents' visits abroad remained broadly the same at 17.0 million
- UK residents' expenditure abroad remained broadly the same at £8.1 billion

#### Overseas visitors to the UK

The estimated number of overseas residents' visits to the UK, seasonally adjusted, in the three months to March 2007 increased by 2 per cent to 8.5 million compared with the previous three months and increased by 2 per cent compared with the three months to March 2006.

The total number of overseas residents' visits to the UK, not seasonally adjusted, increased by 7 per cent during the 12 months ending in March 2007 compared with a year earlier (from 30.2 million to 32.3 million). This was as a result of the number of visits from Europe increasing by 8.0 per cent (to 23.5 million), visits from North America increasing by 5 per cent (to 4.5 million) and visits from other parts of the world increasing by 5 per cent (to 4.4 million). #### UK residents' visits abroad


The estimated number of UK residents' visits abroad, seasonally adjusted, in the three months to March 2007 remained broadly the same at 17.0 million compared with the previous three months and increased by 2 per cent compared with the three months to March 2006.

The total number of UK residents' visits overseas, not seasonally adjusted, increased by 3 per cent during the 12 months ending in March 2007 compared with a year earlier (from 66.7 million to 68.6 million). This was as a result of the number of visits to Europe increasing by 2 per cent (to 54.3 million), visits to North America decreasing by 3 per cent (to 4.5 million) and visits to other parts of the world increasing by 9 per cent (to 9.8 million). 
#### Overseas earnings and expenditure

Comparing the three months to March 2007, seasonally adjusted, with the previous three months, total spending by overseas visitors to the UK (earnings) decreased by 2 per cent to £3.7 billion and spending by UK residents overseas (expenditure) remained broadly the same at £8.1 billion. This resulted in a deficit to the UK of £4.3 billion, unchanged compared with £4.3 billion in the three months to December 2006.

During the 12 months ending March 2007, not seasonally adjusted, overseas earnings increased by 8 per cent to £15.5 billion and expenditure by UK residents increased by 4 per cent to £33.7 billion compared with the previous year. This resulted in a deficit to the UK of £18.2 billion compared with £18.0 billion during the same period to March 2006. (Tables 1 and 4)



#### **BACKGROUND NOTES**

- The figures in this First Release are based on provisional results from the International Passenger Survey (IPS). The IPS is a sample survey and therefore the results are subject to sampling errors. Detailed analyses for Quarter 4 of 2006 may be obtained from the publication MQ6 Overseas Travel and Tourism. Further information and a full breakdown of the figures for 2005 can be obtained from the annual report, Travel Trends (ISBN 1-4039-9309-0) which was published on 8 November 2006. Travel Trends and MQ6 Overseas Travel and Tourism and a compact dataset, Travelpac (giving a selection of variables drawn from the survey) are available from the National Statistics website, www.statistics.gov.uk.
- The main series are seasonally adjusted. This aids interpretation by identifying seasonal patterns and smoothing them out of the unadjusted data. The resulting figures give a more accurate indication of the underlying trend.
- 3. Figures for the most recent months are provisional and subject to revision in light of (a) more accurate data on passenger figures becoming available at the end of each quarter and (b) additional passenger data obtained at the end of the year, and the subsequent revisions to seasonally adjusted estimates that these entail. Non seasonally adjusted data has been revised for previously published time periods. The seasonally adjusted estimates have been revised along the length of the datasets to ensure both non seasonally adjusted and seasonally adjusted estimates are on a consistent basis. An annual review of seasonal adjustment setting is planned for May and this may lead to additional revisions. In addition, ONS has recently begun to publish revisions triangles on the National Statistics website.

With the introduction of Liverpool and Prestwick into the International Passenger Survey Sample from January 2005, methodology was changed to address a discontinuity in results in regional visits to the UK. A review of the seasonal adjustment will take place in May 2007 which may lead to revisions of the seasonally adjusted estimates.

4. One indication of the reliability of the key indicators in this release can be obtained by monitoring the size of revisions. Normally a revisions table would be published in this first release but due to technical reasons it has not been possible to include it at this time.



5. With the enlargement of the European Union on 1 May 2004, there is considerable interest in the number of visits to the UK from these accession countries. To aid the understanding of what is happening, ONS is making available additional analyses of visits to the UK based on IPS data. These show the numbers of visits made by overseas residents who are **nationals** of the European Union, separating out those countries who were EU members before 1 May 2004 and the accession countries.

From 11 April 2007, the Overseas Travel and Tourism First release will adopt the same world geographies used in other publications involving the International Passenger Survey. That means tables will be analysed by North America, Europe and Rest of the World. Additionally information on the enlarged European Union will be shown. This has resulted in slight changes to the back data.

#### North America:

Canada (including Greenland and St Pierre et Miquelon), USA (including Puerto Rico and US Virgin Islands).

#### Europe:

All countries listed under EU27 plus other central & eastern Europe, North Cyprus, Gibraltar, Iceland (including Faroe Islands), Norway, Switzerland (including Liechtenstein), Turkey, the former USSR and the states of former Yugoslavia.

EU15: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France (including Monaco), Finland, Germany, Greece, Irish Republic, Italy (including San Marino and Vatican City), Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal (including Azores and Madeira), Spain (including Canary Islands, the Balearic Islands and Andorra) and Sweden.

EU27: As for EU15 plus, Bulgaria, Cyprus (see \* below), Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia.

\*Only the south of Cyprus is a member of the EU but the IPS is unable to separate North and South Cyprus for the period before May 2004 and so all of Cyprus is included in the EU27 section until May 2004. From May 2004, only southern Cyprus is included in the EU27 figures. Where Cyprus is shown separately in a table, the figures relate to the whole island.
