Clippers C **Mason Plumlee** spent four seasons (2016-20) with the Nuggets, appearing in 244 games (54 starts), averaging 7.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.5 assists in 19.9 minutes ... Clippers G **Brandon Boston Jr.** (2020-21) and Nuggets G **Jamal Murray** (2015-16) played at Kentucky ... Clippers G **Russel Westbrook** (2006-08), Clippers G **Norman Powell** (2011-15), and Nuggets F **Peyton Watson** (2021-22) played for UCLA ... Nuggets C **DeAndre Jordan** played for the Clippers for 10 years, from 2008-18 ... **Jordan** appeared in 750 games (638 starts) and averaged 9.4 points, 10.7 rebounds, and 1.7 blocks in 28.1 minutes ... Nuggets G **Reggie Jackson** played for the Clippers from 2019-23, appearing in 211 games (162 starts), averaging 12.8 points, three rebounds, and three assists in 26.5 minutes ... Clippers G **Bones Hyland** was drafted by the Nuggets in the first round, 26th pick in the 2021 NBA Draft ... **Hyland** played for the team from 2021-23, appearing in 111 games (five starts), averaging 10.9 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 2.8 assists in 19.2 minutes.





ASSIST TO TURNOVER RATIO

Denver has been dishing the rock as of late and it continued in their 119-111 road victory over the Phoenix Suns on 12/1. After handing out 37 assists to only four turnovers vs. Houston on 11/29, the Nuggets followed that up with 38 assists on 50 made field goals and only nine turnovers vs. Phoenix on 12/1. **Nikola Jokic led the way, finishing with 21 points on 9-18 shooting, 16 assists and five rebounds in 35 minutes. He now has a total of 31 assists and three turnovers in his last two games.**

Finally, it was the first time in Nuggets franchise history that all five starters scored 15+ points and had 4+ assists and just the eighth time it's happened in NBA history, last by the Cleveland Cavaliers on 3/16/93.

COMING HOME PARTY

In a game where the Nuggets were missing three starters, DeAndre Jordan and Reggie Jackson returned to their old stomping grounds and put on a show in Los Angeles. Denver, on the second night of a back-to-back took down the Clippers 113-104, outscoring the Clippers by 20 in the fourth quarter. It was the 13th time in team history with that margin in the fourth quarter and just fourth time ever on the road.

The former Clippers Reggie Jackson and DeAndre Jordan combined for 56 points, 18 rebounds, 18 assists on 23-30 FG in the win and added a few more highlights:

- DeAndre Jordan attempted eight shots and made seven (all dunks) and he became the first Nuggets player besides Nikola Jokić with 21/13/5 in a game since April 2018 (Millsap).
- Reggie Jackson joined Nikola Jokic, Giannis Antetokounmpo and Shai Gilgeous-Alexander as the only players since 2020 to record 35+ points, 10+ assists and 5+ rebounds on 75% shooting in game.

BACK TO THE WINNING WAYS

Returning home after a long road trip that resulted in a 1-4 record, the Nuggets got back to their winning ways at Ball Arena on 11/26, beating the San Antonio Spurs 132-120. Denver now has the best home record in the NBA at 8-0 and join the Celtics as the only two teams in the NBA still undefeated at home this season.

Nikola Jokić led the way once again posting 39 points, 11 rebounds, nine assists, and one steal in 34 minutes, finishing with his third consecutive game with 30+ points. It is the 20th time in his career he's finished with back-to-back games with 30+ points and the second time this season (recorded four consecutive games with 30+ points from 11/6-11/14). Jokić is the only NBA player in NBA history with 475+ points, 225+ rebounds, and 150+ assists through the first 17 games of a season.

TRIPLE DOUBLE MACHINE

The big man in the middle for the Nuggets continues to assert his dominance away from home as the Nuggets move along their five-game road swing. Denver fell to the Orlando Magic 124-119 on 11/22, dropping their record to 1-3 on their current trip, but Nikola Jokić continued to be the bright spot. **He finished with 30 points on 12-18 shooting, 13 rebounds, 12 assists and three steals in 36 minutes for his sixth triple double of the season. The rest of the NBA combined has a total of seven.**

A STAT LINE THAT HAS NEVER BEEN SEEN

Despite the 115-110 road loss to the New Orleans Pelicans on 11/17, Nikola Jokić put up some historic numbers that have never been seen in an NBA game before. The Joker posted 26 points on 10-20 shooting, a career high tying 18 assists, 16 rebounds and one steal in 36 minutes, becoming the first player ever to post those numbers in a game. It marked his fifth triple double of the season, and his 18 assists are the most of any player this season.

Jokić now has four career games with 25+ points, 15+ rebounds and 15+ assists, tying Wilt Chamberlain for the second-most career games in NBA history.

STREAKING TO START THE SEASON

Nikola Jokić continued one of his more impressive streaks of his career in the Nuggets 111-108 win over the Los Angeles Clippers on 11/14. The Joker finished with 32 points (8-23 FG's, 14-14 FT's), 16 rebounds and nine assists in 36 minutes. It was his 11th consecutive game with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, the first Nuggets player to ever do that. **He also is the first player since Elgin Baylor in 1967 to start a season with 12 straight games of 20+ points and 10+ rebounds.**

NIGHT IN AND NIGHT OUT

After three days off, the Nuggets traveled to Houston for their third road game of the season. Despite their 107-104 loss, Nikola Jokić had one of his better statistical games of the season, completely dominating the Rockets. The big man finished with 36 points, 21 rebounds and 11 assists in 38 minutes for his fourth triple double of the season.

It marked his third straight game with 35+ points and 10+ rebounds and **his fourth career game with 30+ points, 20+ rebounds and 10+ assists, while the rest of the NBA has only four in that same span. Jokić posted his 10th career triple-doubles with 30+ points and 15+ rebounds trailing only Wilt Chamberlain (20) and Oscar Robertson (29) in such games.**

ANOTHER NIGHT AT THE OFFICE

The Nuggets are off to one of their best starts in franchise history, starting 8-1 for only the third time and Nikola Jokić is a big reason why. Jokić finished with back-to-back 35 points games on 11/6 and 11/8 as the Nuggets ended their homestand with a perfect 4-0 record. Joker posted 35 points, 13 rebounds, five assists, three steals, and one block in 36 minutes against Golden State on 11/8 and 35 points, 14 rebounds, 12 assists, one steal, and one block in 36 minutes vs. New Orleans on 11/6.

Jokić now has 37 career games with 35+ points, 10 rebounds, and five assists (tied for 10th all-time in the NBA). He is also one of three centers with multiple 20-point halves this season, collecting his fourth (20 points in the second half), joining Joel Embiid (2) and Myles Turner (2).

STRAWTHER SNIPING

With Jamal Murray out due to injury, Julian Strawther stepped up when the Nuggets needed him, having the best game of his young career. The rookie recorded 21 points (8-13 FG, 5-9 3FG), two rebounds, and one assist in only 19 minutes off the bench vs. New Orleans on 11/6.

Strawther had the fourth game ever by a Nuggets rookie coming off the bench with five or more 3-point field goals and 20+ points. Also, his five threes are the second most in a game by any rookie this season and he is the first Nuggets player since Bones Hyland in 2022, to have 20+ points off the bench.

CLIMBING THE ALL-TIME LIST

Nikola Jokić continues to dominate the NBA night in and night out and it continued vs. New Orleans on 11/6. The big man posted 35 points (15-24 FG's), 14 rebounds and 12 assists in 36 minutes to lead the Nuggets to a 134-116 victory.

With his triple double, Jokić passed LeBron James and Jason Kidd for the fourth most triple doubles in NBA history with 108 doing so in 813 fewer games than James and 643 fewer than Kidd. He now trails only Magic Johnson (138), Oscar Robertson (181), and Russell Westbrook (198).

PORTER JR. SHINES BACK-TO-BACK NIGHTS

Michael Porter Jr. continues to improve, adding new ways to contribute to the Nuggets winning ways. MPJ was a huge part of the Nuggets home back-to-back sweep against the Mavericks on 11/3 and Bulls on 11/4. He tallied 24 points, nine rebounds, one assist, and two blocks in 34 minutes vs. Dallas on 11/3. And less than 24 hours later, he followed that up with a season-high 27 points, six rebounds, two assists, one steal, and two blocks in 30 minutes vs. Chicago.

Through five games, MPJ has scored 20+ points three times, which means good things for the Nuggets as they are 47-14 all-time when Porter Jr. scores 20+ points in a game.

JOKER AND WILT

The Joker was firing on all cylinders as the Nuggets took down the Dallas Mavericks 125-114, moving their record to 5-1 to start the season and 1-0 for In-Season Tournament pool play. Jokić was efficient as ever, posting 33 points on 14-16 shooting, 14 rebounds, nine assists, one block and one steal in 36 minutes. His start of the season dominance hasn't gone unnoticed as he **is the first player in Nuggets history to begin a season with six straight 20-point, 10-rebound games and is the first NBA player to do so since Joel Embiid in 2018.**

Joker also finds himself on another list with Wilt Chamberlain as he chases down arguably the best center to ever play. He now has seven games with 30+ points, 10+ rebounds while shooting at least 85% from the field. That is the second most in NBA history, trailing Wilt's 12.

BLOWOUT IN OKLAHOMA

In a quick road trip to start the season, the Nuggets were able to secure two wins away from home. During their Sunday matinee against the Thunder, Denver cruised to a 128-95 victory, their biggest on the road since 2022 (at Milwaukee). The Nuggets used a balanced effort on both sides of the floor, holding the Thunder to 6-32 from behind the arc. They also had five players score 13+ points and dished out a season high 34 assists on 53 field goals, shooting 60% from the field (53-88 FG's). Since the start of the 2017-18 season the Nuggets have eclipsed 60% shooting an NBA-best 17 times.

The Nuggets have been flat out dominating to start the season, through three games, they have only trailed for a total of four minutes and 17 seconds, and they look to start the season 4-0 for the sixth time in team history (1976, 1978, 1985, 2009 and 2018).

MPJ HITTING THE GLASS

Michael Porter Jr. has been doing all the little things to start the season, helping the Nuggets get off to another fast start. Although he hasn't been scoring at his normal clip, he has been all over the boards, including in the Nuggets win at MEM on 10/27. Porter Jr. finished with nine points and 13 rebounds in 29 minutes making it his second straight game with 10+ boards.

Denver is now 6-0 all-time when he records 13+ rebounds in game. Also, Porter Jr. had only three games with 10+ rebounds last season and already has seven in 2023-24.

Michael Malone

Michael Malone enters his ninth season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015. He is now the fourth longest tenured coach in the NBA and currently ranks third all-time amongst Nuggets head coaches with 367 wins.

Last season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to their first NBA Championship in franchise history, ending a 47-year long drought. They finished the regular season with a 53-29 record as they clinched the number one overall seed in the Western Conference and playoff berth for the fifth straight year. Denver finished the postseason with a 16-4 record, losing only one home game during the postseason and never having a series go over six games.

Malone has helped lead the Nuggets to at least one playoff series victory in four of the last five seasons. Since 2018-19, Denver has eight playoff series victories, which doubles the franchise total for the previous 32 years. Malone has totaled 37 postseason wins, ranking him first all-time in franchise history for most playoff victories passing Doug Moe with 24.

Since Malone took over prior to the 2015-16 season, the Nuggets have seen the postseason on five occasions including an NBA Championship and two Western Conference Finals appearances in 2020 and 2023. The Nuggets are also second in the NBA, trailing only the Milwaukee Bucks for the most combined regular season and postseason wins in a five-year span with 285. Additionally, based on winning percentage, Malone has overseen four of the top ten seasons in NBA franchise history.

Malone has 406 victories as an NBA head coach and possesses over 26 years of coaching experience, 22 coming in the NBA with six different teams – New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed 14 playoff appearances, including two NBA Finals showing and four conference finals appearances. Malone and his staff have also been selected to coach two All-Star games, most recently in 2023 where he coached Team LeBron at the in Salt Lake City, UT, falling to Team Giannis 184-175.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007.

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46-36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a 272-138 (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 – 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWB camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships.

A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who coached for over 28 years in the league. He and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.
