STARTING FIVE FIRING ON ALL CYLINDERS

Denver hosted a Sunday matinee against the Indiana Pacers on 1/14, before setting out on their longest road trip of the season (five games). The starting group for the Nuggets put on a show for the fans, taking down the Pacers 117-109 winning their seventh straight game against Indiana. That unit was red hot as they scored a season-high 106 points on 70% FG led by Jokic (25 points), Murray (25 points), Porter Jr. (25 points) and Gordon (20 points).

It marked just the ninth time since 1991 three Nuggets starters scored 25+ points in game and the first time since 2/8/22 four Denver players scored 20+ points. As well, it is the first time in franchise history that four starters each had 20+ points on 60%+ shooting.

MPJ HITTING THE BOARDS

Michael Porter Jr. has been hitting the boards all season and it has been a key factor to another fast start from the Nuggets. Porter Jr. posted 20 points, 10 rebounds, one assist, one steal, and one block in 33 minutes to help the Nuggets take down the Pelicans 124-113 on 1/12. **It's his ninth double-double of the season and 40th career game with 10+ rebounds. His nine double-doubles are already tied for the second most in a season in his career (15 in 2020-21).**

When MPJ rebounds, it usually means good things for the Nuggets as they are now 9-2 in games where he grabs 10+ rebounds. Compared to last season he already has eight more games with 10+ boards.

MURRAY BOUNCES BACK

After a rough shooting night in a home loss to Orlando on 1/5, Jamal Murray bounced back as he always does with a huge performance against the Detroit Pistons on 1/7. Murray finished with 37 points, five rebounds, four assists, one steal, and one block in 30 minutes, leading the Nuggets to a 131-114 win. It marked the 12th time in his career finishing with 35+ points as Denver moved to 10-2 in those games.

Murray was red hot from the jump as he scored 24 of his 37 in the first half. It was the sixth time Murray scored 24+ points in a first half and just the second time in his career doing so with 10+ FGM.

FOURTH QUARTER COMEBACK

On the first night of a road/home back-to-back the Nuggets won in dramatic fashion, knocking out the Warriors 130-127 behind Nikola Jokic's game winner. **The Nuggets trailed the Warriors 123-105 with 6:51 to play but closed on a 25-4 run to steal the victory.**

Aaron Gordon led the way in the fourth quarter, scoring 15 points to finish with a season-high 30 to go along with nine rebounds and two assists. Peyton Watson shined once again off the bench, posting 19 points on 6-10 shooting and five rebounds in 19 minutes. A few other highlights from the win:

- **The 18-point deficit tied the 17th biggest comeback win in team history.**
- **It was just the fifth time since 1996 that Denver trailed by 18+ in the fourth quarter and won.**
- **The 10th time in Nuggets history winning a game when trailing by 13+ after three quarters.**

THREE-POINT SNIPING

The Nuggets got back to their winning ways in 2024, taking down the Charlotte Hornets 111-93 at home on New Year's Day. Jamal Murray led the way, finishing with 25 points (7-16 FG, 5-9 3FG, 6-7 FT), three rebounds, seven assists, two steals, and one block in 27 minutes. Murray posted 11 points in the first quarter, marking the most points he's put up in the first quarter this season. As a team, the Nuggets went 15-38 from three-point range, their sixth game this season making 15 or more in a game (5-1).

The Nuggets have now made 10+ three-pointers in 14 consecutive games, marking the fourth longest streak in franchise history. The only other teams with a longer active streak are ATL (27), BOS (16) and LAC (15).

WATSON SHINES AS STARTER

With the Nuggets missing Aaron Gordon due to injury, it was the next man up mentality and Peyton Watson delivered. The Nuggets used an efficient attack to blow out the Grizzlies 142-105 at home on 12/28. Denver finished with a season-high in points (142), field goals made (55), three-pointers (20), rebounds (53), and assists (43). The 43 assists tie the 10th most assists in team history. It's the third time since 1990 with that many assists in a game and the second time in the 2023 calendar year.

The bright spot for the Nuggets was Watson, who finished with 20 points (6-14 FG, 4-10 3FG, 4-4 FT), five rebounds, and two assists in 23 minutes. He set career-highs in points and three-point field goals in his first start of the season, helping deliver the Nuggets a victory.

MURRAY FLURRY ON CHRISTMAS DAY

After Santa came to town the night before, the Nuggets took on the Golden State Warriors in a Christmas Day matinee at Ball Arena. In a back-and-forth game Denver was able to use a strong fourth quarter to take down the Warriors 120-114. Jamal Murray led the way for Denver as he tallied 28 points (10-18 FG, 3-5 3FG, 5-5 FT), five rebounds, three assists, and two steals in 32 minutes. It was Murray's fifth consecutive game with 20+ points and 11th game going 100% from the free-throw line this season.

Murray holds the top three records of most points scored on Christmas Day by a player born in Canada (28 vs. GSW in 2023, 26 vs. PHX in 2022, and 23 vs. LAC in 2020).





THIRD QUARTER TO REMEMBER

The Nuggets wrapped up their pre-Christmas road trip in Charlotte on the second game of a back-to-back on 12/23 and handled their business, taking down the Hornets 102-95. Their defense in the second half was the story of the night, as they allowed only 35 points including nine in the third quarter. Also, the 95 points allowed was the second time this season the Nuggets have held their opponent under 100 in a game (2-0).

The third quarter defense from Denver held Charlotte to 2-22 from the field as they went on a 25-1 run, blowing the game wide open. The last time a Nuggets team held a team to two or fewer field goals in any quarter was at Minnesota on 1/6/16. Ironically, it is the third time this season that an NBA team has made two or fewer FGs in any quarter.

PROTECTING THE ROCK

As the holiday season is in full force, the Nuggets are starting to find their stride, as they moved to 2-0 on their current three game road trip with a 122-117 win over the Brooklyn Nets on 12/22. Denver's duo of Jamal Murray and Nikola Jokic was on full display as they carried the Nuggets down the stretch to the victory. Murray finished with 32 points (26 in the second half), nine assists and five rebounds while Jokic posted 31 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists in 34 minutes. As a team the Nuggets continue to protect the ball, finishing with only six turnovers in the game, continuing to lead the league in that category.

As well, the Nuggets had five straight games with nine or fewer turnovers, which is the longest streak in franchise history.

TOTAL TEAM EFFORT

Denver looked to get back in the winning column as they closed out their three game homestand with a matchup against the Dallas Mavericks on 12/18. The Nuggets used a total team effort to get the blowout victory, taking down the Mavericks 130-104. Jamal Murray posted 22 points, four rebounds, two assists, one steal, and one block in 24 minutes and Aaron Gordon finished with a season-high tying 21 points (7-9 FG, 2-3 3FG, 5-6 FT), five rebounds, five assists, and one steal in 24 minutes. A few other highlights from the win:

- The Nuggets recorded 60 points in the paint, the 10th time this season doing so (8-2).
- Denver finished with a season-high 32 fastbreak points.
- Denver's bench scored a season-high 62 points, compared to the Mavericks 34 ... Four Denver reserves scored 10+ points, the first time doing so since 10/28/22 ... Denver is 11-3 this season when the Nuggets' bench outscores their opponent's bench.
- Zeke Nnaji registered 14 points, four rebounds, two assists, one steal, and one block in 20 minutes, marking a season-high in points and tying his season-high in assists.

BENCH MOB SURGING

The Nuggets bench is starting to come into form as the youth and energy is paying dividends. Denver's bench helped lead the way as they took down the Brooklyn Nets 124-101 at Ball Arena on 12/14. The bench unit was led by Peyton Watson who tallied 18 points (7-10 FG, 2-5 3FG, 2-3 FT), seven rebounds, five assists, one steal, and two blocks in 24 minutes, marking new career-highs in points and assists and a new season-high in rebounds. **The Nuggets bench outscored the Nets bench 58-42 including leading 17-2 at the half and scoring all 34 points in the fourth quarter. Denver's reserves have scored more than 34 in a quarter just 10 times in the last 25 years. Over the three games from 12/11-12/14 the Nuggets bench scored 46 points, 50 points and 58 points while the Nuggets went 3-0 in those games.**

BACK-TO-BACK SUCCESS

So far through 25 games the Nuggets have already had six of their 13 back-to-back sets, which continued 12/12 at Chicago. After taking down the Hawks on 12/11, Denver defeated the Bulls 114-106 on short rest the next night. **The win moved Denver's record to 5-1 on the second night of a back-to-back this season (7-5 last year) and to 16-9 overall. A few other notes from the win:**

- The Nuggets had a season-high 50 bench points (had 50+ 10 times last year).
- Chicago shot 41.9% FG, the third worst by a Denver opponent this season.
- Denver shot 46.7% from three, the second best this season.
- Nuggets move to 8-0 against teams with a sub .500 record.

SPARK FROM STRAWTHER

In the middle of a three-game losing streak, the Nuggets needed a spark to get them back on track and that's exactly what they got from Julian Strawther at Atlanta on 12/11. The rookie had the best game of his young career, posting a career-high 22 points (8-16 FG's, 4-5 3FG's), five steals, two assists and one rebound in 28 minutes to help the Nuggets get a 129-122 victory.

Strawther tied the Nuggets rookie record for most 3pt-FGM in a game with six, joining James Posey in 2000, Juancho Hernangómez in 2017 and Bones Hyland in 2022. His six threes also mark the second most by a rookie in the NBA this season (Hawkins – 7). Strawther also becomes the first rookie in NBA history to record at least six threes and five steals in a game.

ASSIST TO TURNOVER RATIO

Denver has been dishing the rock as of late and it continued in their 119-111 road victory over the Phoenix Suns on 12/1. After handing out 37 assists to only four turnovers vs. Houston on 11/29, the Nuggets followed that up with 38 assists on 50 made field goals and only nine turnovers vs. Phoenix on 12/1. **Nikola Jokic led the way, finishing with 21 points on 9-18 shooting, 16 assists and five rebounds in 35 minutes. He now has a total of 31 assists and three turnovers in his last two games.**

Finally, it was the first time in Nuggets franchise history that all five starters scored 15+ points and had 4+ assists and just the eighth time it's happened in NBA history, last by the Cleveland Cavaliers on 3/16/93.

JUST CAN'T MISS

Once again, the big man in the middle for the Nuggets is shooting the basketball at a clip rarely seen before in NBA history. The Nuggets hosted a Sunday matinee against the Indiana Pacers on 1/14 and Jokić tallied 25 points (12-13 FG, 1-2 FT), 12 rebounds, nine assists, two steals, and one block in 33 minutes, leading Denver to their 28th win of the season.

It is the third time in a calendar year he has reached 25+ points, 12+ rebounds, and nine or more assists on 90+% shooting. Outside of Jokić, that stat line has only been achieved five times in NBA history with the last time being in 1998. As well, over his last nine games, Jokić is shooting 85-105 from the field. It is the first time in NBA history a player has shot 80% from the field or better in a nine-game span (min. 100 attempts).

DOING WHATEVER IT TAKES

Nikola Jokić will flat out do whatever it takes to win a basketball game. He proved exactly that on 1/7 vs. Detroit, as he posted four points (2-3 FG's), seven rebounds, 16 assists, and five blocks in 24 minutes, helping Denver win 131-116 for their 26th win of the season. The line from the Joker was one of the more unique in NBA history, a few notes from the win:

- Tied his career-high in blocks which was set on 4/12/17.
- **One of two NBA players since 1982-83 to have 16+ assists and five or more blocks in a game ... The other player was Nuggets' Jalen Rose (16 assists, six blocks vs. BOS on 2/18/96).**
- First player since Russell Westbrook on 12/8/15 to have 16+ assists in under 25 minutes.

SHOOTING LIGHTS OUT

The Joker has been almost automatic shooting the ball from all over the floor the last four games. It continued at Golden State on 1/4, as Jokić posted 34 points (13-16 FG's), 10 assists and nine rebounds while hitting a game winning three at the buzzer to cap the Nuggets 18-point comeback. The big man is on a stretch of near perfection, going 39-44 from the field during the four-game stretch. Jokić once again joins only Wilt Chamberlain on a list of NBA history. Since Wilt, he has the highest FG% over a four-game span in the shot clock era (since 1954-55) with a minimum of 40 attempts.

THE PERFECT TRIPLE DOUBLE

As if achieving a triple double isn't hard enough, Nikola Jokić made it look easy in front of the home crowd against the Memphis Grizzlies on 12/28. The Joker put on show, not missing a shot the entire night. He finished with 26 points on (11-11 FG's, 1-1 3FG's, 3-3 FT's), 14 assists and 10 rebounds for his league leading 11th triple double of the season and 116th of his career.

He became the first player to post a 20+ point triple-double on 100% shooting (FG's, 3FG's, and FT's). It also marks the third time in his career he has a perfect shooting triple double, joining Wilt Chamberlain as the only players to have three or more.

FRANCHISE LEADER

In his ninth season with the Nuggets, Nikola Jokić now stands alone as the rebound king of Denver. The Joker grabbed 11 rebounds to go along with his 31 points and seven assists in the Nuggets 122-117 win over the Brooklyn Nets on 12/22. **He now has a total of 6,631 rebounds in a Nuggets uniform, passing Dan Issel for the most in franchise history, doing so in 625 games.**

A SPECIAL THREE-YEAR STRETCH

Once again, the Joker finds himself on a list with only one other name in NBA history. Jokić had a big performance against the Raptors on 12/20, where he posted a game-high 31 points (13-23 FG), 15 rebounds and six assists, leading the Nuggets to a 113-104 win. It was his fourth 30-point, 15-rebound game of the season leading all players in the NBA this season in such games.

Over the last three calendar years (since Jan. 1, 2021), Jokić has recorded 6,236 points, 2,917 rebounds and 2,068 assists — The only other player in NBA history to record 6,000+ points, 2,500+ rebounds and 2,000+ assists over a three-year span is Oscar Robertson from 1961 to 1963.

10+ IN SEVEN STRAIGHT SEASONS

Nikola Jokić has done something again that no other player in NBA history has done, continuing to cement himself as one of the greats to ever play the game. The Joker finished with 26 points, 15 rebounds, 10 assists, and one steal in 29 minutes vs. BKN on 12/14, marking his 10th triple double of the season and 35th of his career before the fourth quarter (only 11 NBA players have had more than 35 triple-doubles in their entire career).

Jokić becomes the first player in NBA history to have seven consecutive seasons with 10+ triple-doubles, which was previously held by Oscar Robertson who had six straight seasons. Jokić is also one of three players in NBA history to have 10+ triple-doubles in their first 25 games of a season (Russell Westbrook in 2020-21 and 2016-17 and Oscar Robertson in 1961-62).

PLAYER OF THE MONTH

The NBA has announced on 12/4 that Nikola Jokić was named Western Conference Player of the Month for games played in October/November, winning the award for the seventh time in his career, the most in franchise history. The two-time MVP averaged 29.0 points, 13.2 rebounds and 9.2 assists while shooting .571 from the field and .316 from three-point range in 18 games during October and November. He helped lead the Nuggets to a record of 12-6 in games in which he played, and they are currently third in the Western Conference.

Jokić recorded seven triple-doubles in the month span, while the rest of the NBA combined for eight total. He had four straight games of 30+ points to end November, making it the second time in the month recording a four-game stretch scoring 30 or more points (11/6 – 11/14). He also became the first player since Elgin Baylor in 1967 to start a season with 12 straight games of 20+ points and 10+ rebounds.





TRIPLE DOUBLE MACHINE

The big man in the middle for the Nuggets continues to assert his dominance away from home as the Nuggets move along their five-game road swing. Denver fell to the Orlando Magic 124-119 on 11/22, dropping their record to 1-3 on their current trip, but Nikola Jokić continued to be the bright spot. **He finished with 30 points on 12-18 shooting, 13 rebounds, 12 assists and three steals in 36 minutes for his sixth triple double of the season.**

A STAT LINE THAT HAS NEVER BEEN SEEN

Despite the 115-110 road loss to the New Orleans Pelicans on 11/17, Nikola Jokić put up some historic numbers that have never been seen in an NBA game before. The Joker posted 26 points on 10-20 shooting, a career high tying 18 assists, 16 rebounds and one steal in 36 minutes, becoming the first player ever to post those numbers in a game. It marked his fifth triple double of the season, and his 18 assists are the most of any player this season.

Jokić now has four career games with 25+ points, 15+ rebounds and 15+ assists, tying Wilt Chamberlain for the second-most career games in NBA history.

STREAKING TO START THE SEASON

Nikola Jokić continued one of his more impressive streaks of his career in the Nuggets 111-108 win over the Los Angeles Clippers on 11/14. The Joker finished with 32 points (8-23 FG's, 14-14 FT's), 16 rebounds and nine assists in 36 minutes. It was his 11th consecutive game with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, the first Nuggets player to ever do that. **He also is the first player since Elgin Baylor in 1967 to start a season with 12 straight games of 20+ points and 10+ rebounds.**

NIGHT IN AND NIGHT OUT

After three days off, the Nuggets traveled to Houston for their third road game of the season. Despite their 107-104 loss, Nikola Jokić had one of his better statistical games of the season, completely dominating the Rockets. The big man finished with 36 points, 21 rebounds and 11 assists in 38 minutes for his fourth triple double of the season.

It marked his third straight game with 35+ points and 10+ rebounds and **his fourth career game with 30+ points, 20+ rebounds and 10+ assists, while the rest of the NBA has only four in that same span. Jokić posted his 10th career triple-doubles with 30+ points and 15+ rebounds trailing only Wilt Chamberlain (20) and Oscar Robertson (29) in such games.**

CLIMBING THE ALL-TIME LIST

Nikola Jokić continues to dominate the NBA night in and night out and it continued vs. New Orleans on 11/6. The big man posted 35 points (15-24 FG's), 14 rebounds and 12 assists in 36 minutes to lead the Nuggets to a 134-116 victory.

With his triple double, Jokić passed LeBron James and Jason Kidd for the fourth most triple doubles in NBA history with 108 doing so in 813 fewer games than James and 643 fewer than Kidd. He now trails only Magic Johnson (138), Oscar Robertson (181), and Russell Westbrook (198).

JOKER AND WILT

The Joker was firing on all cylinders as the Nuggets took down the Dallas Mavericks 125-114, moving their record to 5-1 to start the season and 1-0 for In-Season Tournament pool play. Jokić was efficient as ever, posting 33 points on 14-16 shooting, 14 rebounds, nine assists, one block and one steal in 36 minutes. His start of the season dominance hasn't gone unnoticed as he **is the first player in Nuggets history to begin a season with six straight 20-point, 10-rebound games and is the first NBA player to do so since Joel Embiid in 2018.**

Joker also finds himself on another list with Wilt Chamberlain as he chases down arguably the best center to ever play. He now has seven games with 30+ points, 10+ rebounds while shooting at least 85% from the field. That is the second most in NBA history, trailing Wilt's 12.

Michael Malone enters his ninth season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015. He is now the fourth longest tenured coach in the NBA and currently ranks third all-time amongst Nuggets head coaches with 367 wins.

Last season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to their first NBA Championship in franchise history, ending a 47-year long drought. They finished the regular season with a 53-29 record as they clinched the number one overall seed in the Western Conference and playoff berth for the fifth straight year. Denver finished the postseason with a 16-4 record, losing only one home game during the postseason and never having a series go over six games.

Malone has helped lead the Nuggets to at least one playoff series victory in four of the last five seasons. Since 2018-19, Denver has eight playoff series victories, which doubles the franchise total for the previous 32 years. Malone has totaled 37 postseason wins, ranking him first all-time in franchise history for most playoff victories passing Doug Moe with 24.

Since Malone took over prior to the 2015-16 season, the Nuggets have seen the postseason on five occasions including an NBA Championship and two Western Conference Finals appearances in 2020 and 2023. The Nuggets are also second in the NBA, trailing only the Milwaukee Bucks for the most combined regular season and postseason wins in a five-year span with 285. Additionally, based on winning percentage, Malone has overseen four of the top ten seasons in NBA franchise history.

Malone has 406 victories as an NBA head coach and possesses over 26 years of coaching experience, 22 coming in the NBA with six different teams – New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed 14 playoff appearances, including two NBA Finals showing and four conference finals appearances. Malone and his staff have also been selected to coach two All-Star games, most recently in 2023 where he coached Team LeBron at the in Salt Lake City, UT, falling to Team Giannis 184-175.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007.

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46-36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a 272-138 (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 – 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWB camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships.

A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who coached for over 28 years in the league. He and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.
