- 2) When you get there, type in your name (pseudonyms are allowed, but we encourage real names), and click on "enter chat." This will bring up a new screen.
- 3) At the bottom, you will see your name and a box next to it. Just type what you'd like to say into the box (we suggest brief comments, as if one is "chatting"), and click "Say."
- 4) Your statement will appear in the space above, along with those of whomever else is currently contributing with comments to the "chat". To "chat" again, simply repeat.
- 5) When you want to leave the session, just close the window.
