What data do we collect?

Lights for Liberty collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)
- · Event locations

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Lights for Liberty with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- · Register online for an event
- · Complete an event form
- · Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

Lights for Liberty collects your data so that we can:

- · Process your registration
- · Email you concerning events and information
- · Respond to your inquiries

Lights for Liberty does not share your data with anyone else.

How do we store your data?

Lights for Liberty securely stores your data in a secure encrypted database through Ontraport.

Marketing

Lights for Liberty may send you information about events and related organizing tools. We do not share your data with anyone else.

You can always opt out of receiving emails from us.

You have the right at any time to stop Lights for Liberty from contacting you for organizing purposes.

What are your data protection rights?

Lights for Liberty would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request Lights for Liberty for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Lights for Liberty correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Lights for Liberty to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that Lights for Liberty erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that Lights for Liberty restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to Lights for Liberty's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that Lights for Liberty transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

- Advertising Lights for Liberty uses these cookies to collect information about your visit
 to our website, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about
 your browser, device, and your IP address.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
