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### Obama lead down to just 2 points in Iowa

**Raleigh, N.C.** – PPP's newest Iowa poll finds Barack Obama ahead of Mitt Romney by 2 points in a survey conducted over the weekend (47-45). This poll finds a change from the July 16 survey, where Obama was up by 5 (48-43). Candidate approval remains crucial in Iowa, as it identifies as a swing state for the upcoming Presidential election. Obama and Romney are neck and neck, with 45% of voters approving of Barack Obama's job performance and 47% favorability to Mitt Romney.

"Barack Obama's lead in Iowa has steadily declined in our polling over the last three months," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "He still has a narrow advantage, but it's clear that the state deserves its perceived swing state status."

Wind energy remains a hot topic among voters in Iowa. The poll finds 54% of Iowans support the tax credit for wind energy production companies. Wind energy in Iowa is one of the fastest-growing industries in the nation, and after Romney dismissed the importance of wind energy earlier this month, only 37% of voters support Romney on the issue, while 47% trust Obama. This comes with 68% of Iowans finding wind energy an important issue in their state.

Health care remains an important issue to voters in Iowa. 46% of those polled stated they are against Paul Ryan's proposal for reforming Medicare. Additionally, 51% of women and 40% of men are against Ryan's plan. An ever growing elderly population in Iowa also shows their disapproval of Ryan's plan- 49% of those older than 65 say they oppose Ryan's proposal, followed by 45% of those between 46 and 65 against Ryan's proposition.

PPP will release more findings from its Iowa poll later in the week, including an early look ahead to how voters in the state feel about potential 2016 Presidential candidates.

Public Policy Polling surveyed 1,244 likely Iowa voters from August 23-26. The margin of error for the survey is +/-2.8%. This poll was not paid for or authorized by any campaign or political organization. PPP surveys are conducted through automated telephone interviews.
