People Over the Pentagon Resolution

Presented by John Hogan at the January 16, 2024, DC 47 Executive Board Meeting & approved by the DC 47 Executive Board. It was then presented by John Hogan at the January 17, 2024, DC 47 Delegates Meeting & was approved by the DC 47 Delegates.

Be It Resolved, that AFSCME District Council 47 supports legislation that significantly reduces the excessive Pentagon budget without cutting pay or benefits of those serving in the US military; one such bill is HR 1134, the People Over the Pentagon Act, introduced by Rep. Barbara Lee (D-CA) and Rep. Mark Pocan (D-WI), which would reduce the Pentagon budget by \$100 billion and redirect that money to urgent domestic and international human needs; and

Resolved, that AFSCME District Council 47 will urge the labor bodies with which it is affiliated to pass similar resolutions in support of sensible priorities;

Resolved, that AFSCME District Council 47 will inform the **People Over Pentagon Campaign** so that its support for cutting the military budget, as proposed in H.R. 1134, can be publicly listed as an organizational endorser.
